Kee Yee on his sixty (60) years of Federal Government
Service.**

1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY I MINA'BENTE OCHO NA LIHESLATURAN**

3 **WHEREAS** Mr. Kim Kee Yee was born on February 18, 1928, in Hawaii,
4 to Kon Fok Yee and Kui Len Lau; and

5 **WHEREAS**, on December 1, 1956, Mr. Kim Kee Yee married his loving
6 wife Anita Benavente Santos and they are blessed with five (5) children: Sarah
7 Yee Zenger-Pfannenstiel, Matthew Yee, Vicenta Yee Espinosa, Joseph Yee, and

1 James Yee and they are also blessed with eleven (11) grand children: Olivia
2 Grace Zenger, Jason Yee Espinosa, Kevin Yee Espinosa, Samantha Yee, Kimmi
3 Yee, Dominica Yee, Anika Yee, Jamisha Yee, Jamiamm Yee, Jamera Yee, and
4 Skye Yee; and

5 **WHEREAS**, his parents blessed him with his siblings James K.L. Yee of
6 Kaneohe, HI., Kim Ping Yee of Waipahu, HI., and Bernice Baily of Kaneohe,
7 HI.; and

8 **WHEREAS**, Mr Kim Kee Yee attended Waipahu High School, Waipahu,
9 HI., from 1941 through 1945; and

10 **WHEREAS**, Mr Kim Kee Yee, while attending high school, earned
11 Thirty Six Cents (\$.36) per hour, as a part-time laborer; and

12 **WHEREAS**, December 6, 1945 was his first day as a Federal worker and
13 that date also served as his Federal Service Computation Date (SCD); and

14 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Kim Kee Yee joined the United States Army in 1945
15 through 1946 and received an Honorable Discharge from active duty from the
16 82nd Airborne, All-American Division and earned Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) per
17 month while being stationed at Ft. Bragg, North Carolina and performed over
18 fifty (50) paratrooper drops during his enlistment; and

19 **WHEREAS**, in 1946, Mr. Kim Kee Yee began his career with the U.S.
20 Navy at the Pearl Harbor Naval Shipyard in Honolulu, HI., as a Sheet Metal
21 Worker in Shop seventeen; and

22 **WHEREAS**, in 1946, Mr. Kim Kee Yee was hired by the Civil
23 Aeronautics Administration (CAA) of the U.S. Department of Commerce and
24 arrived on Guam in 1948; and

1 **WHEREAS**, during his career, Mr. Kim Kee Yee received numerous
2 Special Act and Service Awards as well as Performance, Time-Off and
3 Monetary Awards, as an Electronics Technician (GS-856-12) and eventually
4 held the position as an Airway Transportation System Specialist (ATSS) (FV-
5 2101-H) with the Air Traffic Organization – Technical Operations (ATO-W);
6 Western Service Area (WSA); and

7 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Kim Yee’s hobbies continue to be golf and gardening;
8 and

9 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Kim Yee remains an instrumental part in the daily
10 operations with the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) on Guam; now,
11 therefore, be it


12 **RESOLVED**, that *I Mina’Bente Ocho Na Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby
