3 **WHEREAS**, James Michael Santos Artero was born on June 1, 1981 to
4 James Michael Flores Artero and Theresa S. Witt; and

5 **WHEREAS**, James Michael Santos Artero attended school at P. C. Lujan
6 Elementary School in Radio Barrigada, Inarajan High School, and graduated

1 in 1999 from Guam Community College (GCC); and

2 **WHEREAS**, in order to serve his country, James Michael Santos Artero
3 enlisted in the United States Navy in the year 2000; and

4 **WHEREAS**, his desire to succeed in his career prompted outstanding
5 performance evaluations from his superiors, and he was awarded a number of
6 medals of commendation; and

7 **WHEREAS**, James Michael Santos Artero was awarded the National
8 Defense Service Medal on September 11, 2001; the Armed Forces
9 Expeditionary Medal on February 6, and March 3, 2003; the Global War on
10 Terrorism Award on March 8, 2003; the Sea Service Award on April 6, 2003; a
11 Good Conduct Award on September 9, 2003; and a Navy Unit Commendation
12 on March 3, 2004 and May 3, 2004; and

13 **WHEREAS**, in the last evaluation given to James Michael Santos Artero,
14 it was recommended by his superior officer recommended that James Michael
15 Santos Artero be Duty Instructor, noted that he was a superb administrator,
16 managing over twenty-five (25) personnel, and described him as a motivating
17 team leader who developed three (3) watch teams consisting of thirty-three
18 (33) junior personnel, enabling the U.S.S. Tarawa to complete every mission;
19 now, therefore, be it

21 on behalf of the people of Guam, memorialize the contributions and
22 accomplishments of James Michael Santos Artero, affectionately known as
23 "Mikie", and express the heartfelt condolences of the people of Guam to his

2 the people of Guam, recognize the family of the late James Michael Santos
3 Artero for their sacrifices and unselfish support during his years of service to

7 thereafter transmitted to the family of the late James Michael Santos Artero;
