2 Maria Margaret Camacho and Kasper Dudkiewicz, now married to Connie
3 Dudkiewicz, and is married to Katie Dudkiewicz of California, also is serving
4 in the active duty in the Army in Korea; and

5 **WHEREAS**, Army Pfc. Kasper Allen Camacho Dudkiewicz, was the
6 third eldest of nine (9) brothers, two (2) of whom also serve in the United
7 States Armed Forces of America, and two (2) sisters; and

8 **WHEREAS**, Army Pfc. Kasper Allen Camacho Dudkiewicz, has served
9 in the United States Army for the last three (3) years and was assigned for Iraq
10 last November 2005; and

17 family, the people of Guam and all closest to him; now, therefore, be it


18 **RESOLVED**, that *I Mina' Bente Ocho Na Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby,
