1           **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE OF I MINA'BENTE OCHO NA**  
2 **LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:**

3           **WHEREAS**, Ms. Freida A. Jose began her career with the Guam Visitors  
4 Bureau as its Executive Secretary on September 1, 1982; and

5           **WHEREAS**, in her capacity as Executive Secretary, in addition to  
6 providing support to the General Manager, she was also responsible for  
7 preparing documents for, and taking minutes of, the Guam Visitors Bureau's  
8 Board of Directors meetings; and

9           **WHEREAS**, in November of 1983, Ms. Jose was appointed to the  
10 position of Administrative Assistant and made responsible for the  
11 coordination of Guam Visitors Bureau's membership activities; and

12           **WHEREAS**, four (4) years later, Ms. Jose was given the title of Special  
13 Projects/Membership Officer, and was designated as the lead staffer to be  
14 involved in those capital improvement projects approved by the Guam  
15 Visitors Bureau Board of Directors and funded through legislative  
16 appropriations from the Tourist Attraction Fund and other sources; and

17           **WHEREAS**, over the past eighteen (18) years, Guam Visitors Bureau has  
18 been ably represented by Ms. Jose in various programs and projects including  
19 the Fifty Two Million Dollars (\$52,000.00) Tumon Bay Development Project,  
20 the annual Tumon and *Hagatña* Beach Cleaning and Maintenance Contracts,  
21 the Tumon Landscaping and Maintenance Contracts, the Island-wide  
22 Roadways Beautification and Maintenance project, the Holiday Illumination  
23 project, and the Island Village Beautification project; and

1           **WHEREAS**, Ms. Jose has been a fixture since 1983, in the organizing and  
2 conducting of the quarterly Guam Visitors Bureau’s Membership meetings  
3 and the biennial election of the industry’s four (4) members to the Guam  
4 Visitors Bureau’s Board of Directors; and


5           **WHEREAS**, after having served the Guam Visitors Bureau for almost
