3 **WHEREAS, Guam and the Philippines have a strong and enduring**
4 **friendship, rooted in our political, cultural, and economic relationship; and**

1 **WHEREAS**, the Filipino community is Guam’s second largest ethnic
2 group; and

3 **WHEREAS**, for the last several decades, thousands of Filipinos and
4 their families from the Province of Pangasinan, one (1) of the seventy-nine (79)
5 provinces of the Philippines, have chosen to migrate to Guam, adopting
6 Guam as their home; and

7 **WHEREAS**, the Pangasinanes on Guam have politically, culturally,
8 and socially assimilated into Guamanian society, and continue to this day to
9 distinguish themselves as honest, hard-working, and family oriented people
10 in our community; and

11 **WHEREAS**, to foster unity and closer relationships among
12 Pangasinanes on Guam, and to actively promote civic, social and moral
13 welfare, the Federation of the Pangasinanes was founded; and

14 **WHEREAS**, the Federation of the Pangasinanes on Guam is one of
15 about eighty (80) Filipino associations and organizations in Guam; and

16 **WHEREAS**, on February 25, 2005, the Federation of the Pangasinanes
17 on Guam will be celebrating the 3rd Anniversary of its founding, as well as the
18 first formal Induction Ball of its officers and board of directors; and

19 **WHEREAS**, to commemorate this historic occasion, the Federation of
20 the Pangasinanes on Guam invited the Honorable Oscar B. Lambino as their
21 honored guest speaker; and

22 **WHEREAS**, the Federation of the Pangasinanes on Guam is also

6 Julian V. Resuello, City Mayor of San Carlos City; and


7 **WHEREAS**, other Pangasinan Provincial Government officials will also

17 further


18 **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker certify, and the Secretary of the
