3 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Merlin J. Miller has provided outstanding contributions
4 to Anderson Air Force Base and to our Island of Guam; and

5 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Miller, during his three (3) year tour on Guam, served
6 as the Deputy of the 36th Civil Engineer Squadron, 36th Mission Support
7 Group, the 36th Air Base Wing, Anderson Air Force Base, Guam; and

1 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Miller epitomizes both the military and the community
2 servant; and

3 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Miller arrived on Guam on the 22nd of June 2003 as a
4 leader who supervises the activities of more than four hundred forty (440)
5 personnel in the daily acquisition, design and construction, fire protection,
6 explosive ordinance disposal, environmental compliance, natural resource
7 management, family housing management, operations, maintenance and
8 repair of all Air Force facilities on Guam and the surrounding Mariana
9 Islands; and

10 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Miller also planned and established land use and
11 provided environmental stewardship over the largest forest in Guam; and

12 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Miller has led PACAF as the best small Civil
13 Engineering Squadron for three (3) years running and, last year, PACAF was
14 named one of the three (3) best in the Air Force; and

15 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Miller has developed a twenty (20) year plan for
16 Anderson that includes significant operations, maintenance, military
17 construction investment and future growth; and

18 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Miller was instrumental in delivering a Thirty-Two
19 Million Dollar (\$32,000,000) Air Expeditionary Hangar, a Fifteen Million
20 Dollar (\$15,000,000) Fitness Center, a Twelve Million Dollar (\$12,000,000)
21 Security Forces complex and a Twenty-Four Million Dollar (\$24,000,000)
22 runway replacement at Anderson Air Force Base, Guam; and

1 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Miller led the \$1.9B Global Strike Force Beddown plan
2 and construction needs, and ensuring a wise facility and land use plan for the
3 future of Anderson Air Force Base; and

4 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Miller was recognized by The Inspector General, the
5 Pacific Air Forces, and acknowledged the 36th Civil Engineering Squadron
6 personnel accountability under his leadership and noteworthy key to
7 Command and Control receiving an outstanding rating, supporting the Wing
8 with an overall “Excellent” under his leadership; and

9 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Miller consistently goes above and beyond the call of
10 duty and his efforts have most certainly improved the quality of life for many
11 people of Anderson Air Force Base and the island of Guam. He is most
12 deserving of this most prestigious award; and

13 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Miller has given unselfishly of his time and energy to
14 make the life of Team Anderson and the civilian community of Guam better
15 each day; now, therefore, be it


16 **RESOLVED**, that *I Mina’ Bente Ocho Na Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby,
