Relative to commending and congratulating Lt. Colonel Brian D. Anderson, United States Air Force, for his highly successful tour of duty on Guam and particularly for his efforts to promote a better relationship between the United States Air Force and the people of Guam.

1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY I MINA'BENTE OCHO NA LIHESLATURAN**
2 **GUÅHAN:**

3 **WHEREAS**, since arriving on Guam in May 2004, Lt. Colonel Brian D.
4 Anderson has served as the Deputy Commander of the 36th Mission Support
5 Group, 36th Air Expeditionary Wing, located at Andersen Air Force Base,
6 which provides essential mission support such as engineering,
7 communications and information, contracting, logistics readiness, security

1 forces, and personnel-related services to the largest air base in PACAF,
2 consisting of more than nine thousand (9,000) active and retired military and
3 civilian and dependent personnel; and

4 **WHEREAS**, Lt. Colonel Brian D. Anderson assists his commander in
5 leading a total of eight hundred eleven (811) military personnel and five
6 hundred ninety eight (598) civilian employees in seven (7) squadrons and one
7 GSU unit. Lt. Anderson also provides security, logistical, personnel, and law
8 enforcement services covering nineteen thousand (19,000) acres valued at
9 approximately Six Billion Four Hundred Million Dollars (\$6.4 Billion); and

10 **WHEREAS**, Lt. Colonel Brian D. Anderson oversees the U.S. Air Force's
11 largest fuel storage facility and largest War Reserve Material Inventory, while
12 ensuring the proper administration of wartime and peacetime contingencies;
13 and

14 **WHEREAS**, Lt. Colonel Brian D. Anderson initiated the Scrub Off Base
15 Access Policy that balances security issues with the need to attract off-base
16 customers to services available at Andersen Air Force Base; and

17 **WHEREAS**, Lt. Colonel Brian D. Anderson coordinated effective
18 planning in accordance with the Base Realignment and Closure Legislation,
19 developing a joint installation management proposal while fostering a close
20 working relationship with the Pacific Naval Command; and

21 **WHEREAS**, through his collaboration with Guam's public and private
22 sectors, Lt. Colonel Brian D. Anderson coordinated efforts with the U.S. Navy
23 and the Office of Civil Defense to develop pilot Weapons of Mass Destruction
24 Response Training Programs for over two hundred fifty (250) personnel; and

1 **WHEREAS**, Lt. Colonel Brian D. Anderson partnered with Guam’s
2 Homeland Security Office during various readiness exercises aimed at
3 preparing the entire island for emergencies resulting from natural disasters
4 and terrorist activities; and

5 **WHEREAS**, Lt. Colonel Brian D. Anderson attended the General
6 Membership Meetings hosted by Guam’s Chamber of Commerce as an official
7 representative of the U.S. Air Force and worked diligently as a member of the
8 Chamber’s Armed Forces Committee involving the USO Center and B-29
9 Memorial projects; and

10 **WHEREAS**, Lt. Colonel Brian D. Anderson also addressed various
11 environmental issues relative to Guam’s historical and cultural identity,
12 including the release of the Marianas Crow, ESOHCAMP inspection, and the
13 re-opening of the *Tarague* trails; and


14 **WHEREAS**, through his leadership, the 36th Mission Support Group, 36th
15 Air Expeditionary Wing of the U.S. Air Force has enhanced its ability to meet
16 mission readiness, training objectives and recruiting and retention goals in
17 support of its wartime and territorial missions; now, therefore, be it

18 **RESOLVED**, that *I Mina’ Bente Ocho Na Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby,
19 on behalf of the people of Guam, commend and congratulate Lt. Colonel Brian
20 D. Anderson, United States Air Force, for his highly successful tour of duty on

22 the United States Air Force and the people of Guam; and be it further


23 **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker certify, and the Secretary of the
