12 country and Guam; and


13 **WHEREAS**, Ms. Nita Baldovino has staunchly advocated open dialogue

23 *Yu'os ma'åse'* for her contributions to our island community; and be it further


24 **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker certify, and the Secretary of the
