7 **WHEREAS**, throughout his twenty-five (25) years of service in the
8 National Guard, LTC Martinez has provided outstanding contributions to the
9 island of Guam, through community service, the protection of the public and
10 fighting for our nation overseas; and

11 **WHEREAS**, LTC Martinez has been awarded numerous medals, awards
12 and badges, by the Armed Forces, including: Meritorious Service Medal;
13 Army Commendation Medal (1st OLC); Air Force Commendation Medal;
14 Army Achievement Medal; Army Reserve Components Achievement Medal;
15 National Defense Service Medal (1st OLC); Global War on Terrorism Medal;

20 yrs); and


21 **WHEREAS**, LTC Martinez has continued his education as an officer

4 National Guard, the people of Guam and our nation; and be it further


5 **RESOLVED**, that *I Mina'Bente Ocho Na Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby
