3 **WHEREAS, Mrs. Angelica "Angie" B. Cruz was born on March 29, 1951**
4 **to Maria Briggemann Flores and Francisco F. Borja on the island of Guam and**
5 **is married to Mr. George P. Cruz, with whom she has four (4) children, Eric,**
6 **Heather Joy, Tisha Renee and Jorge Jarek; and**

1 **WHEREAS**, Mrs. Angelica Cruz graduated from the Guam Community
2 College (GCC) in 1986 with an Associates in Arts Degree in Office
3 Administration with an emphasis in Secretarial Administration; and

4 **WHEREAS**, Mrs. Angelica Cruz began her career in government service
5 in 1972 with the Deaf and Blind Program, Guam Department of Education,
6 and in 1975, transferred to the position of Clerk Typist IV, at the Ordot Chalan
7 Pago Elementary School; and

8 **WHEREAS**, with that appointment, Mrs. Angelica Cruz spent the next
9 thirty-one (31) years to perfecting her trade as an administrative professional
10 with the Guam Public School System (GPSS) at Ordot Chalan Pago
11 Elementary School; and

12 **WHEREAS**, Mrs. Angelica Cruz's diligent work and dedication
13 facilitated her steady rise at Ordot Chalan Pago Elementary School from Clerk
14 to Secretary II from 1981 to 1995 and Administrative Assistant from 1995 to
15 1998, and to the post from which she retires, Administrative Officer, Ordot
16 Chalan Pago Elementary School GPSS, 1998 to 2006; and

17 **WHEREAS**, while employed with the island's public school system,
18 Mrs. Angelica Cruz continued to ensure that she remained well-versed in her
19 trade by obtaining her Associates in Arts Degree at Guam Community
20 College, attending the former International Business College in Tamuning,
21 and taking advantage of training through the years including, Public Service,
22 Records Management, and Professional Development for Secretaries
23 Workshops from the Department of Administration, Government of Guam;

10 personifies the definition of public service; now, therefore, be it


11 **RESOLVED**, that *I Mina’Bente Ocho Na Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby,
