3 **WHEREAS**, after graduating from Southern High School in 1998, Mr.
4 John Hattig, Jr. was drafted by the Boston Red Sox in the 25th round of the
5 Major League Baseball first-year players' draft. In the same year, Mr. Hattig

1 signed a contract to play for the Red Sox and was assigned to play for
2 Boston's Rookie League affiliate, Ft. Meyers in the Gulf Coast League; and

3 **WHEREAS**, in June of 2000, Mr. Hattig was promoted to the Lowell
4 Spinners, Boston's short season Class A affiliates in the New York-Penn
5 League. A year later, Mr. Hattig was promoted to the Augusta, Greenjackets,
6 Boston's low Class A affiliate. In April of 2002, Mr. Hattig was promoted to
7 the Sarasota Red Sox, Boston's high Class A affiliate, and in 2003, Mr. Hattig
8 was promoted to the Portland Sea Dogs of the Eastern League, Boston's
9 Double-A affiliate. In July of 2004, Mr. Hattig was assigned to the Syracuse
10 Skychiefs, Toronto's Triple-A affiliate; and

11 **WHEREAS**, in August of 2006, Mr. Hattig was promoted to the major
12 leagues and is expected to join the Toronto Blue Jays, a testament to his
13 immeasurable hard work and unyielding determination to achieve his dream
14 of playing in major league baseball; and


15 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Hattig's success story speaks to the discipline, respect,

22 be it further


23 **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker certify, and the Secretary of the
