3 from kindergarten through grade four (4); and

4 **WHEREAS**, Nicolas attended home schooling during his 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup>  
5 grade years with his mother, Connie, as his teacher. Also, during his middle  
6 school years, Nicolas attended Inarajan Middle School. Upon completing his  
7 middle school requirements, he moved on to the high school level at the  
8 Guam Seventh Day Adventist School in Windward Hills. Nicolas was also a  
9 very active member of the Junior Achievement Program on Guam; and

10 **WHEREAS**, on February 19, 2005, Nicolas was nominated to the  
11 “People to People Future Leaders Summit 2005” by a person unbeknown to  
12 the Lane family. He received a letter from People to People Leaders  
13 recommending him for this prestigious honor for demonstrating leadership

16 world’s most promising young people for the opportunities and

25 Nicolas will make lasting friendships with future colleagues from around the


1 globe and will rank among the elite in academic and career pursuits; now,
