3 **WHEREAS**, Jude Anthony Flores Martinez was born on January 23,

6 **WHEREAS**, from 1990 to 1995, Jude attended the Infant of Prague
7 Nursery and Kindergarten class receiving certificates at this very young age in
8 the Honor Roll for Third Scholastic Achievement, and Handwriting Award
9 for Outstanding Achievement; and

10 **WHEREAS**, from grades 1st through 8th, Jude attended Bishop
11 Baumgartner Memorial School garnering numerous Certificates of
12 Achievements and Awards in Mathematics, Art, and *Chamorro* while in the 1st
13 grade. He received the Social Studies Award and made the "A" Honor Roll in
14 the 2nd grade. He also received the Honorable Mention Award in all subjects,
15 the Citizen Certificate for Exemplary Behavior and Valuable Service while in
16 the 3rd grade. He received the Outstanding Achievement Award in Activity
17 Service, a Certificate of Excellence in Penmanship, Certificate of Participation
18 in BBMS Science fair and was a member of the Student Council in the 4th
19 grade. While in the 5th grade, Jude received the Certificate of Excellence in
20 Physical Education, Spelling and a Certificate of Achievement in the Science
21 Fair; and

22 **WHEREAS**, from 6th through 8th grades, Jude continued his outstanding
23 trend of accomplishment by receiving the Student of the Month Award for
24 April 2001, and became a Student Council Marshal of his class. In the 7th

19 **WHEREAS**, as a Sophomore, Jude was the Class Treasurer, the Friars'
20 Team Captain for Track & Field. He was voted the "Rookie of the Year" for
21 the Friars' Varsity Basketball Team, and was an "A" Honor Roll Student in the
22 first quarter and "B" Honor Roll in the 2nd and 3rd quarters. He participated in
23 the Philippines Friendship Tournament, the Far East Tournament in Okinawa,
24 the Inaugural Asia-Pacific Cross Country Invitational and the FD Phoenix 5K
25 Run/Walk; and

2 Thompson, the Head Coach for the Junior-Varsity Basketball Team and the
3 Vice Principal of Father Duenas Memorial School to be a candidate for the

18 of Guam to service our people and our community; and be it further


19 **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker certify, and the Secretary of the
