3 WHEREAS, the people of Guam acknowledge that child abuse is a

4 problem felt by the entire island community; and

WHEREAS, the protection of our children must be a priority of all 1 2 members of the community; and

WHEREAS, approximately three million (3,000,000) children nationally 3 4 and approximately two thousand (2,000) children locally are reported abused 5 and neglected each year; and

WHEREAS, efforts to prevent child abuse can be made by schools, day 6 7 care centers, and other child-serving entities by reporting suspected cases of 8 child abuse and neglect; and

WHEREAS, prevention of child abuse and neglect can be promoted 9 through education to children in the classroom; and 10

11 WHEREAS, family members and neighbors can also take an active role 12 by reporting children who may be victims of child abuse or neglect; and

WHEREAS, community support programs that provide education in 13 parenting skills, resources for day-care services, access to home-health 14 15 visitors, counseling and support networks must be implemented as method of 16 prevention; and

17 WHEREAS, youth engaged in prevention programs offer positive 18 alternatives for young people and encourage youth to develop strong ties to 19 their community; and

WHEREAS, the Guam Department of Public Health and Social Services, 20 Bureau of Social Services Administration has partnered with other agencies 21 22 for education, intervention and prevention of child abuse and neglect; now, 23 therefore, be it

1 **RESOLVED**, the month of April, 2005, is recognized as Child Abuse 2 Prevention Month, "Safe Children and Healthy Families are a Shared 3 Responsibility", and to honor and extend *un dångkolo' na si Yu'os ma'åse'* to the 4 employees of the Department of Public Health and Social Services, Bureau of 5 Social Services Administration, Child Protective Services, and other 6 government organizations and volunteers who provide service and care for 7 children throughout the year; and be it further

8 **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker certify, and the Secretary of the 9 Legislature attest to, the adoption hereof, and that copies of the same be 10 thereafter transmitted to the Department of Public Health & Social Services 11 Child Protective Services Division; and to the Honorable Felix P.
