19 Technician, also supervising and training all inhalation therapy technicians on
20 procedural blood gas tests and in the operation of related equipment; and

21 **WHEREAS**, 1987, Dr. Adalia Z. Fernandez became the Deputy Director
22 of Guam Health Planning and Development Agency following her
23 employment at Parm-Medic Company from 1980 to 1986; and

1 **WHEREAS**, Dr. Adalia Z. Fernandez’s career in the government of
2 Guam continued as she served as a Staff Assistant to the Governor of Guam,
3 and later returning to her former position at the Guam Health Planning and
4 Development, subsequently entering the field of real estate rental, thereby
5 retiring from her exceptional years of government service; and

6 **WHEREAS**, the Filipino Ladies Association of Guam will now greet its
7 new President, welcoming an educated professional, outstanding leader, and
8 dedicated contributor to our island community; and

9 **WHEREAS**, the Filipino Ladies Association of Guam has served as an

12 commendation are in order; now, therefore, be it


13 **RESOLVED**, that *I Mina’ Bente Ocho Na Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby,
