3 **WHEREAS,** Captain David M. Boone was born in Cheverly, Maryland,
4 raised in Taiwan and Japan, and graduated from high school in Portland,
5 Oregon; and

1 **WHEREAS**, he graduated with Honors from California Polytechnic
2 State University at San Luis Obispo, California with a Bachelor of Science
3 Degree in Civil Engineering in 1982; and

4 **WHEREAS**, Captain Boone was commissioned an Ensign in 1983 and
5 attended the Civil Engineer Corps Officer Basic Course and then reported for
6 duty with Naval Mobile Construction Battalion FORTY; and

7 **WHEREAS**, he has been homeported in Port Hueneme, California, and,
8 in addition to Guam, has served on deployments to Rota, Spain and
9 Guantanamo Bay, Cuba; and

10 **WHEREAS**, Captain Boone became the Commanding Officer, Public
11 Works Center, Guam; the Officer in Charge of Construction, Marianas; and
12 the Regional Engineer, Commander, Naval Forces Marianas, in August 2003;
13 and

14 **WHEREAS**, Captain Boone provided critical, professional leadership in
15 several U.S. Navy/Government of Guam initiatives: to transfer Navy dredge
16 spoils to GOVGUAM to aid in the construction of its proposed 1500'
17 commercial pier at HOTEL wharf; to promote concept development for the
18 proposed Defense Access Road linking Naval Base Guam and Andersen Air
19 Force Base; and served as the keynote speaker and driving force behind the
20 recently commissioned Guam Land Use Master Plan Group that will
21 contribute to improved relations between the Navy and Government of Guam
22 and their business partners; and

23 **WHEREAS**, his efforts directly supported the warrior's mission,
24 including utilities upgrades in support of submarine warfare, a forward
25 operating logistics hangar, a security forces building, and a new fitness center

1 for the Air Force, and two (2) readiness center facilities for the Army National
2 Guard; and

3 **WHEREAS**, Captain Boone's accomplishments in the awarding of
4 construction contracts to small businesses resulted in high praise and
5 recognition from the U.S. Small Business Association, the Guam Chamber of
6 Commerce and the Guam Contractors Association, including achieving a
7 significant milestone by awarding NAVFAC Marianas' first Javits-Wagner-
8 O'Day (JWOD) contract and the first set-aside to Historically Underutilized
9 Business Zones (HUBZone) and Service-Disabled Veteran-owned small
10 business concerns; and

11 **WHEREAS**, Captain Boone's strong support and commitment to small
12 business was recognized by the presentations to the U.S. House of
13 Representatives Small Business Delegation and commentary by
14 Congresswoman Madeleine Z. Bordallo (Guam-D) in January 2005; now,
15 therefore, be it


16 **RESOLVED**, that *I Mina'Bente Ocho Na Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby,
