3 **WHEREAS**, Howard E. Davis, affectionately known as "Ed Davis", was
4 born on June 10, 1946 in Ottenheim, Kentucky to his proud parents, Mr.
5 Howard E. and Mrs. Agnes (Farr) Louis Davis; and

1 **WHEREAS**, Ed Davis is married to his loving bride, Maria Fernandez
2 Alicto of Dededo, and they are blessed with three (3) children named Patrick,
3 Robert and CherMarie, and are also blessed with six (6) grandchildren named
4 Patrick Jr., Cyrus, Trinity, Aaron, Christian, and Christina; and

5 **WHEREAS**, Ed Davis came to Guam in 1968 as a member of the United
6 States Air Force and honorably retired in 1970; and

7 **WHEREAS**, Ed Davis had the privilege of working with many
8 companies in the private sector to include, Playboy Enterprises, Foremost
9 Guam, Calvo’s Enterprises, F.L. Moylan Co., and Continental Airlines, before
10 entering the media on Guam; and

11 **WHEREAS**, Ed Davis media career started in 1980 with Don Brown at
12 KATB Radio, as the music host of dong music radio; and

13 **WHEREAS**, after the sale of KATB to Sorensen Broadcast Group, he
14 went from doing the Morning Drive show to working the 6 p.m. to Midnight
15 shift and doing late night production; and

16 **WHEREAS**, Ed Davis went from KGUM to KUAM as the program
17 director for 610AM, where he worked with the likes of J.Q. *Fanihi*, Uncle Tote,
18 Melinda Coates, Hutch & Jeff, John Gerber and many other Guam radio
19 legends; and

20 **WHEREAS**, Ed Davis went to work for the Government of Guam as the
21 Public Information Officer for the Bureau of Planning, where he started the
22 “*Guåhan* Man, Land, and Sea”, which is aimed at informing the people of
23 Guam about protecting the environment for generations to come, and while
24 working with the Bureau of Planning he was the host of the Morning Drive
25 Show and the Music Director for KSTO; and

1 **WHEREAS**, while working for former Governor Joseph F. Ada he was
2 selected to be the Operations Manager (Deputy Director) of KGTF (Guam’s
3 Public Television Station), during which time KGTF saw great period of
4 growth; and

5 **WHEREAS**, after leaving KGTF, he took on the responsibility of
6 Operations Manager at Catholic Radio; and

7 **WHEREAS**, upon the ending of his contract with Catholic Radio, he
8 entered the Tourist industry, while still doing voice-over work and writing for
9 radio and TV; and

10 **WHEREAS**, as a tour bus driver he was approached by Joe Couch of
11 Glimpses about taking over the in-house audio/video production
12 department, and, still having the urge for electronic media, he gladly took the
13 job; and

14 **WHEREAS**, after leaving Glimpses, he continued to do communication
15 and voice-over work along with market research, and after a couple of years
16 doing freelance work, he took up employment at Andersen Air Force Base in
17 the Transportation Department, becoming the Chief of Vehicle Operations
18 and still doing voice-over work as time would allow; and

19 **WHEREAS**, Ed Davis’ career as a broadcast journalist and a respectable
20 commentator, and due to other events in his life, caused him to seek the radio
21 airwaves once again with Sorensen Pacific, which set the stage for the “ON
22 THE GO” segment for Sorensen Pacific Broadcasting; now, therefore, be it


23 **RESOLVED**, that *I Mina’Bente Ocho Na Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby,
