3           **WHEREAS,** the Filipino Ladies Association of Guam was founded in  
4 1962 by a group of Filipino ladies aimed at fostering unity and closer relations  
5 among members, preserving the cherished Filipino traditions of its members  
6 and to improve and conserve the bonds of friendship with the people of  
7 Guam; and

8           **WHEREAS,** the Filipino Ladies Association of Guam has taken active  
9 participation in the promotion of civic, social and moral welfare in our island  
10 community to include beautification, infrastructure projects and improving  
11 the lives of countless residents especially the infirmed and people most in  
12 need with monetary donations for on and off-island medical treatment; and

1           **WHEREAS**, the Filipino Ladies Association of Guam (FLAG) continues  
2 its University of Guam scholarship assistance program for two (2) students  
3 every semester, donating valuable medical equipment to the Guam Memorial  
4 Hospital and assisting their homeland in times of natural calamities; and

7 Little Miss Sampaguita Fundraising beauty contest where participants exhibit

10 members, the Little Miss Sampaguita contestants and various other Filipino  
11 organizations jointly celebrated with the Philippine Independence Day  
12 celebration; and

14 two (2) international women's organization - the Washington General  
15 Federation of Women's Club and the Federation of Asian-Pacific Women's  
16 Association (FAPA); and

17           **WHEREAS**, under the leadership of Ms. Herminia Jardiolin I 2007, the  
18 Filipino Ladies Association of Guam provided much needed financial  
19 assistance to various educational, religious and community support programs  
20 including the American Red Cross, the American Cancer Society, the

22 Carmelite Sisters, and the University of Guam; and

2 Ms. Gloria Banguinon as its new President for the year 2007, embracing this
