Relative to remembering Army Staff Sergeant Joseph Duenas Gamboa for his unselfish service to the United States of America and the people of Guam, for making the ultimate sacrifice in combat while serving in the United States Armed Forces on March 25, 2008, and extending a heartfelt *Si Yu'os Ma'ase'* and sincere condolences to Mrs. Michelle G. Gamboa and family and all of their relatives and friends.

1 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE OF *I MINA* 2 BENTE NUEBI NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:

WHEREAS, Army Staff Sergeant Joseph "Joe" Duenas Gamboa was born in Kentucky on July 22, 1973 to Francisco Manalisay and Cecilia Duenas Gamboa; and

5 WHEREAS, Joe attended Hillside Elementary School in Washington state, and 6 after the family returned to Guam he attended Dededo Middle School, Inarajan High 7 School, and Guam Community College; and

8 WHEREAS, on October 23, 1995 Joe married Michelle Doreen Borja 9 Guerrero, and began to create a life of their own; and

WHEREAS, in an effort to improve his life and better provide for his family, Joe chose to follow in his father's footsteps and joined the United States Army in 2000, and following basic training, he was stationed at Fort Lewis, Washington; and

WHEREAS, Joe proved to be an excellent soldier and worked his way up the
 ranks to his present rank of Staff Sergeant; and was eventually assigned to the 1st
 Squadron, 14th Cavalry Regiment, 3rd Brigade, 2nd Infantry Division, Stryker
 Brigade Combat Team, stationed at Fort Lewis, Washington; and

WHEREAS, Sergeant Gamboa was first deployed to Iraq in 2005, during which he narrowly avoided injury or worse by keeping his unit at their jobsite rather than going to the mess tent, and by doing so avoided a suicide bomber who blew himself up in the mess tent; and

21 WHEREAS, following his safe return from his first deployment to Iraq in 22 2006, Sergeant Gamboa was given a list of three (3) bases to be assigned to, and he chose Vilseck, Germany as his next duty station, and in June and August of 2006 he
 and his family made the long journey from Fort Lewis, Washington to Vilseck,
 Germany and began the next chapter of his military career as a member of B
 Company, 1st Squadron, 2nd Stryker Cavalry Regiment, V Corps; and

5 **WHEREAS,** Sergeant Gamboa was given notice of his unit being scheduled 6 for deployment to Iraq, and in August of 2007 he began his second tour in Iraq; and

WHEREAS, seven (7) months into his second deployment and just two (2)
weeks shy of his turn for "R&R" and a reunion with his wife and children, he was
wounded and succumbed to his injuries on March 25, 2008; and

WHEREAS, Sergeant Joseph Duenas Gamboa is survived by his loving wife 10 Michelle and their children Krystianna Mychailla, Austin Joseph, Ashton Joseph, 11 Savannah Joelle[†], Avery Joseph, and Isabella Jomia; his parents, Francisco M. and 12 Cecilia D. Gamboa; his siblings Francisco, Marcy G. Rose, Vincent, Ann Margaret, 13 Evelyn, Kanny, Linda G. Salas, and Norbert Apatang; his parents-in-law Pedro S.N. 14 and Angela Guerrero and Dorothy B. and Michael D. Carlson; his siblings-in-law 15 Peter J. and Gloriana P. Guerrero, and Perry J. Guerrero; and numerous other family 16 members and friends; and 17
