Relative to honoring and recognizing the accomplishments of the Honorable James Chen-Yu Chin during his diplomatic career, and his contributions to the community of Guam.

1 BE IT RESOLVED BY I MINA' BENTE NUEBI NA LIHESLATURAN

3 WHEREAS, James Chen-Yu Chin assumed the post of Director General for
4 the Taipei Economic and Cultural Office in Guam during April of 2004; and

5 WHEREAS, James Chen-Yu Chin has completed an extensive career in
6 diplomatic relations, serving as: Desk Officer for the Ministry of Foreign Affairs,
7 Assistant at the Taipei Economic and Cultural Representative Office in Switzerland,
8 Section Chief for the Department of Information and Cultural Affairs at the Ministry
9 of Foreign Affairs, Section Chief for the Department of Protocol at the Ministry of
10 Foreign Affairs, Deputy Director of Division at the Taipei Economic and Cultural
11 Representative Office in the United States, Assistant Director General for the
12 Department of International Organizations at the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Deputy
13 Director General for the Department of International Organizations at the Ministry of
14 Foreign Affairs, and most recently, Director General for the Taipei Economic and
15 Cultural Office in Guam; and

1 **WHEREAS**, during the Directorship of James Chen-Yu Chin at the Taipei
2 Economic and Cultural Office in Guam, President Chen Shui-ban of the Republic of
3 China has made three visits to Guam, during January 2005, May 2005, and September
4 2006, and Vice President Hsiu-lien Lu of the Republic of China visited Guam in
5 January 2008; and

6 **WHEREAS**, other tourist media, performing groups, sports teams, and
7 investors from the Republic of China have been visiting Guam during the past
8 five years; and

9 **WHEREAS**, James Chen-Yu Chin, in order to promote cooperation and a
10 working relationship in the arena of public security and forensic science, invited the
11 Guam Chief of Police to visit the Republic of China in 2006; and

12 **WHEREAS**, James Chen-Yu Chin has a wife Grace, an active member of the
13 Guam community, who has been the Honorary President of the Chinese Ladies'
14 Association of Guam, has been a member of the Guam Council of Women's Club,
15 and has served as a volunteer for the Guam Memorial Hospital in excess of four
16 hundred hours; and

17 **WHEREAS**, during his tenure on Guam, James Chen-Yu Chin has
18 strengthened the bilateral relations between the Republic of China and Guam, which
19 has enhanced Guam's public visibility; now, therefore, be it

20 **RESOLVED**, that *I Mina' Bente Nuebi Na Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby,
21 on behalf of the people of Guam, honor and recognize James Chen-Yu Chin for his
22 honorable career accomplishments and for his selfless service to the community of
23 Guam; and be it further

24 **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker certify, and the Secretary of the Legislature
25 attest to, the adoption hereof, and that copies of the same be thereafter transmitted to;
26 and to the Honorable Felix P. Camacho, *I Maga'lahren Guåhan*.
