Kennedy High School, and in the 23 following year included such trainings in the middle and elementary schools; and 24

WHEREAS, Inafa'Maolek Conciliation has provided over one hundred and twenty

included the Department of Defense schools; and

WHEREAS, Inafa'Maolek provides a wide variety of specialized conflict resolution workshops for students to include Date Rape/Dating Violence, Bullying, Racial-Ethnic Conflict, Suicide, Sexual Harassment, Peer Pressure, Bulimia and Bystander Response; and WHEREAS, trainings and workshops are also expanded to parents, teachers, school support staff and school administrators and is also offered as continuing education credits at

the University of Guam; and

WHEREAS, trainings and workshops creatively use the art of drama which appropriately is named "Pace Theater Skits" which compose of a youthful training team; and

WHEREAS, Inafa'Maolek has been the lone voice on Guam for Restorative Justice for over fifteen (15) years providing interventions and training; and

WHEREAS, Inafa'Maolek has organized and hosted for our island community two annual conferences, the "Island-wide Peer Mediation" also known as PeaceStock Conference and the "Peace Talk/Peacemaker Conference" which is targeted for Conflict Awareness for adults both in schools and other occupational settings; now, therefore, be it
