3 WHEREAS, the Honorable Jesus De La Rosa Santos was  
4 born November 16, 1923, to the late Luis Alvarez and the  
5 late Joaquina De La Rosa Santos and was called to his eternal  
6 rest on September 7, 2008; and

1       **WHEREAS**, in his new life, the Honorable Jesus De la  
2 Rosa Santos now joins his brothers Antonio, Jose and Luis,  
3 and his sister Alfonsina Cruz; and

4       **WHEREAS**, the Honorable Jesus De La Rosa Santos was  
5 blessed in marriage and will be forever loved and  
6 remembered by his wife, Dolores White Santos and further  
7 blessed with his children and their spouses Lewis J.W. and  
8 Mary Cruz Santos, Carmelita S. and John G. Concepcion,  
9 Bernadette S. and Peter Lufrano, Therese S. and Frank Banta,  
10 Barbara S. and Anthony Lufrano, III, and Paul A.W. and  
11 Anita T. Santos; and

12       **WHEREAS**, the Honorable Jesus De La Rosa Santos was  
13 the proud grandfather and great-grandfather of twenty-one  
14 (21) grandchildren and fourteen (14) great-grandchildren;  
15 and

16       **WHEREAS**, the Honorable Jesus De La Rosa Santos is  
17 additionally survived by his two (2) sisters and their  
18 spouses, Vicenta S. and Stanley Botelho, Julia S. Flores and  
19 Joseph Perez, and by his brother and spouse, Francisco D.

1 and Mary Fern Santos, and is further survived by his sisters-  
2 in-law, Magda Santos and Freddie Van Dox Santos, and by  
3 numerous relatives, nieces, and nephews; and

4       **WHEREAS**, following his successful bid for the office of  
5 Commissioner (now known as Mayor) during the 1968  
6 general election, the Honorable Jesus De La Rosa Santos was  
7 sworn into office on January 1969 and served until the  
8 expiration of his term in January 1973; and

9       **WHEREAS**, the Honorable Jesus De La Rosa Santos,  
10 utilizing his extensive knowledge and experience working at  
11 the Department of Land Management, provided advice and  
12 support to the people of Mangilao regarding land issues;  
13 and

14       **WHEREAS**, the Honorable Jesus De La Rosa Santos  
15 fought for and facilitated access to critical services for the  
16 *man'am ko* of Mangilao and throughout the island;

17       **WHEREAS**, the Honorable Jesus De La Rosa Santos  
18 served and represented his village diligently proudly  
19 assisting to nurture and guide the growing village that today

1 hosts the island's only university and community college,  
2 several government agencies, public and private schools,  
3 non-profit organizations, and many other businesses; and

4 **WHEREAS**, the Honorable Jesus De La Rosa Santos also  
5 served as a member of the Commissioner's Council of  
6 Guam (now known as the Mayor's Council of Guam), the  
7 Guam Greyhound Commission, and the South Pacific  
8 Games Commission; now, therefore, be it

9 **RESOLVED**, that *I Mina'Bente Nuebi Na Liheslaturan*  
10 *Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of the people of Guam,  
11 recognize and acknowledge the accomplishments and  
12 achievements of the late Honorable Jesus De La Rosa Santos
