3 WHEREAS, CTSI Logistics had their beginnings in 1989 as  
4 Consolidated Transportation Services Inc., the freight forwarding arm of its  
5 parent company Tan Holdings, servicing Guam, the Northern Marianas,  
6 and Micronesia; and

7 WHEREAS, in 1991 CTSI built their first warehousing facility in  
8 Guam for consolidated freight service operations and for several years  
9 focused on freight forwarding as well as on the growing businesses within  
10 the Pacific islands, giving CTSI solid experience in cargo consolidation, as  
11 well as building a loyal client base for their business; and

1           **WHEREAS**, in 1995 CTSI opened an office at the Antonio B. Won Pat  
2 International Airport to better serve its growing list of customers, and in  
3 1997 became an agent for foreign shipping line Mariana Express Lines,  
4 Ltd., (MELL), opening an office at the Jose D. Leon Guerrero Commercial  
5 Port; and

6           **WHEREAS**, the rapid expansion and globalization of businesses in  
7 the 1990s helped CTSI take its services to the next level, bringing on board  
8 a young and dynamic team of Information Technology and Logistics  
9 professionals who helped the company evolve into an integrated logistics  
10 provider, subsequently re-naming itself CTSI Logistics; and

11           **WHEREAS**, with their broad knowledge of the industry, strong  
12 information technology expertise, and specialized customer service,  
13 providing air freight service capabilities and on-land service requirements  
14 including trucking, warehouse management and storage, in addition to its  
15 ocean freight services; and

16           **WHEREAS**, CTSI Logistics now encompasses 27 stations in 12  
17 countries across North America, Asia and the Pacific, stretching from  
18 Vietnam to New York City; and

19           **WHEREAS**, CTSI's current operation in Guam continues its growth  
20 and expansion, with the groundbreaking of a new Airport Facility

1 Warehouse to take place at the Won Pat International Airport on December  
2 18, 2008; and

3 **WHEREAS**, this new facility, especially during a time when  
4 economies worldwide are experiencing a slowdown, demonstrates CTSI  
5 Logistics' commitment to our island and our people; now therefore, be it
