RELATIVE TO RECOGNIZING THE MANY CONTRIBUTIONS MADE BY MR. WALTER "WALLY" DIAS AND BIDDING HIM BEST WISHES AND BUEN VIAJE AS HE ASSUMES HIS NEW POSITION AS MANAGING DIRECTOR – GREATER CHINA AND SOUTHEAST ASIA IN HONGKONG.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

WHEREAS, Mr. Walter Dias is the eldest of seven children to Walter Sr. and Virginia Dias
and was raised in the Pocono Mountains in Pennsylvania; and

WHEREAS, after earning his Bachelors of Science in Accounting from Pennsylvania State
University, Mr. Dias joined the prestigious firm Price Waterhouse and later worked at Geosource,
Inc., where he obtained his license as a Certified Public Accountant, prior to joining Continental
Airlines in 1987; and

8 WHEREAS, Mr. Walter "Wally" Dias moved to Guam in 1993 as Director of Marketing for 9 Continental Micronesia, and was later promoted to Staff Vice-President of Sales and Marketing 10 responsible for the development and execution of sales and promotion programs, advertising and 11 public relations in Guam, People's Republic of China, Hong Kong, Taiwan, South Korea and 12 Taiwan, the Philippines, Australia, Saipan, the Republic of Palau, the Federated States of 13 Micronesia, and Republic of the Marshall Islands, and offshore sales in Southeast Asia; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Dias was one of the prime movers of our Visitor Industry and served four terms as a member of the Guam Visitors Bureau's Board of Directors, and held the positions of chair of GVB's Market Research committee, chair of GVB's China Asia Marketing committee, and as chair of the North America, Pacific and Armed Forces marketing committee from 2003 to 2005; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Dias also served on the board of the Guam Visitor Industry Education
 Council and on the Pacific Asia Travel Association Board of Directors for four years; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Dias worked to increase awareness of our region and boost visitor arrivals
by participating in the development of the popular "Warmth of Paradise" multi-media advertisement

campaign, the "Resort Shuttle" campaign that featured works of art customized for Continental
 Micronesia by popular Australian artist Ken Done, and the "Magnificent Micronesia" program; and

WHEREAS, realizing the potential of Micronesia, Mr. Dias increased service to the region
through flights from Taiwan, New Caledonia and Australia; and

5 WHEREAS, with the growth of China's economy, Mr. Dias worked with Continental's head 6 office to request for special bi-lateral rights in the U. S. and China agreement for Guam and 7 Micronesia, and lead a delegation of Guam passengers on an inaugural charter flight to Shanghai in 8 2008; and

9 WHEREAS, Mr. Dias was instrumental in several humanitarian efforts including 10 coordinating the travel of 2,000 Kurdish refugees to the Mainland in 1994, assisted in the 11 repatriation of fishermen who were lost at sea to their home country, coordinated cargo shipments of 12 medical supplies, clothing and food to devastated countries such as India, Philippine and Chuuk; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Dias was one of the founders of the Ayuda Foundation in 1996, and was instrumental in launching the Wings For Life One Pass program for patients in need of off-island medical care in Micronesia; and

WHEREAS, in his leisure time, Mr. Dias is involved in the Rotary Club of Guam, the
 Micronesia Area Research Council, the Guam Hotel and Restaurant Association Jingle Bell Run,
 and the Junior Golfers group; now therefore be it
