Cardiac diagnostic studies can also be performed at GMH then reviewed by a cardiac intervention list or surgeon for possible treatment; today, GMH is presently certified by the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMMS) formally known as the Health Care Financing Administration (HCFA), and its Blood Bank is accredited by the American Association of Blood Bank (AABB); and its mammography machine is also certified by the American College of Radiology; and
