WHEREAS, the Inetnon Lalahen Guahan over the years has extended its service and support to the island community in many ways, i.e. offering scholarships in higher education to future leaders of the island; supporting members actively participating in various public, civic, and religious organizations; preserving the Chamorro culture and heritage through the support of programs within the public schools and in the villages; and in assisting its fellow members through providing guidance and leadership in their support and contribution to the community; and

WHEREAS, the Inetnon Lalahen Guahan through its many years of existence has promoted and encouraged its membership to leadership service in the community; with numerous members having served in the capacity as Governor of Guam, Senators, Judges, President of the University of Guam, Directors of government agencies, and successful business owners and entrepreneurs; and
