



**Relative to calling on the people of Guam to observe Monday, May 28, 2007, "Memorial Day" with a moment of silent prayer and to encourage all residents to display the United States and the Guam Flags at half-staff from their homes and businesses on this day.**

- 1        **BE IT RESOLVED BY I LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:**
- 2        **WHEREAS**, Memorial Day takes on a special significance in years like this
- 3 one when we as Pacific Islanders are actively reminded on a daily basis of the
- 4 dangers, sacrifices and nobility of military service; and
- 5        **WHEREAS**, hundreds of Guam's men and women are currently serving their
- 6 country as part of Operation Iraqi Freedom and Operation Enduring Freedom. Some
- 7 of our fighting men and women have died in service in Operation Iraqi Freedom and
- 8 Operation Enduring Freedom; and

1           **WHEREAS**, on this Memorial Day, we pause to honor the memory of the  
2 brave men and women who served our country and our island so valiantly with  
3 dignity, and with honor, and who paid the ultimate sacrifice in these conflicts; and

4           **WHEREAS**, Memorial Day is an occasion of special importance for all of us,  
5 because it provides each of us the opportunity to honor our loved ones and friends  
6 who made the supreme sacrifice for the liberties we enjoy. It is also imperative that we  
7 remember those men and women who are currently in harm's way protecting our  
8 freedom world wide; now, therefore, be it

9           **RESOLVED**, *I Mina'Bente Neubi na Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby call  
10 on the people of Guam to pause on this special day of remembrance to recognize and  
11 honor Guam's young men who have lost their lives while serving our Nation in war.  
12 More importantly, *I Mina'Bente Neubi na Liheslaturan Guåhan* encourages our  
13 residents to take part in ceremonies, parades, and other activities in a tribute to those  
14 who have given so nobly to our island and country; and be it further

15           **RESOLVED**, *I Mina'Bente Neubi na Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby ask  
16 the people of Guam to observe this day with a moment of silent prayer and encourage  
17 all residents to display the United States Flag together with the Guam Flag at half-  
18 staff from their homes and businesses on Monday, May 28, 2007; and be it further

19           **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker certify and the Legislative Secretary attest to,  
20 the adoption hereof and that copies of the same be thereafter transmitted to the  
21 Honorable Madeleine Z. Bordallo, Guam's Delegate to the United States Congress  
22 and to the Honorable Felix P. Camacho, *Maga'lahaen Guåhan* Governor of Guam.
