- WHEREAS, Mrs. Patricia Santos Sison, was born on December 9, 1933,
- 4 the daughter of former Senator Tomas Ramirez Santos and Asuncion Hanui
- 5 Blaz; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Mrs. Sison has been a devoted wife to her husband Peter
- 7 and a nurturing mother to Robert, Randall, Linda and Arlene; and
- 8 WHEREAS, after Mrs. Sison received her Bachelor of Arts Degree in
- 9 English/Speech for Secondary Education with a minor in Library Science
- 10 from the University of Guam in 1972, she became employed by the
- Department of Education as an Assistant Librarian at John F. Kennedy High

- School, and thus began her distinguished educational career; and
- 2 WHEREAS, Mrs. Sison extended her education by earning a Master's
- 3 Degree in Educational Administration and Supervision from the University of
- 4 Guam in 1975; and
- 5 WHEREAS, through her exemplary dedication and hard work as an
- 6 Assistant Librarian, Mrs. Sison was rewarded by being promoted to the
- 7 position as Head Librarian at Dededo Junior High School, now known as
- 8 Vicente SA Benavente Middle School, a position she served well and faithfully
- 9 for twenty four (24) years until her retirement in September 30, 2000; and
- WHEREAS, from 1982 to 1983, Mrs. Sison spearheaded the "Save the
- 11 Children" Program, which featured youths' concerns and solutions to child
- abuse, drug abuse and juvenile delinquency, Senators were impressed by the
- 13 students' presentation, they provided funding to send two (2) students to
- attend the "Save the Children Hearing in Washington D.C.; and
- WHEREAS, in 1991, Mrs. Sison coordinated a letter writing campaign
- with Judy Salas' seventh (7<sup>th</sup>) grade gifted and talented education class to the
- servicemen and women serving in the Persian Gulf War, and a valentine card
- to President George W. H. Bush, and in recognition of the students' efforts,
- 19 President George W. H. Bush sent a letter of appreciation thanking the
- students for their concerns about the Persian Gulf War; and
- WHEREAS, in 1994, Mrs. Sison was the first librarian at Dededo Middle
- 22 School to computerize the entire library collection into the Columbia Library
- 23 System making it easier and convenient for students, faculty and staff to
- 24 locate books and AV materials; and

WHEREAS, Mrs. Sison was a prominent figure in lobbying the passage of Public Law 22-140, making it possible to expand the library facilities of

3 Dededo Middle School in 1996, and after her retirement, in recognition of her

4 contributions to the school, the library was named in her honor; and

WHEREAS, in 1998, Mrs. Sison was instrumental in persuading Governor Gutierrez to purchase twelve (12) state of the computers for the use of the students; and

WHEREAS. during her tenure as Head Librarian, Mrs. Sison proved to be an invaluable asset by offering her time and efforts to school activities such as Public Relations Officer for the Parent Teacher Organization; the Dededo Middle School Faculty/Staff Social Club; the School Level Improvement Program; National Library Week Reading Program; Celebrity Readers Reading Program; Read-A-Thon Program; Science Fair Contributor and Supporter; the Future Teachers of America; Dededo Middle School Readers Club; Certified Facilitator for Rainbows for All Children; and Chamorro Week Supporter and Promoter; and

WHEREAS, the island community recognizes the contributions of Mrs. Sison in making sure the island's youth are educated and productive members of society; and

WHEREAS, Mrs. Patricia Santos Sison has been bestowed with the honor of being one of Guam's premiere educators, by the Guam Chapter of the Phi Delta Kappa and is being inducted into the "Guam Educator's Hall of Fame,"; now, therefore, be it
