- WHEREAS, the late Mr. Alvaro Mabugnon Abaday was born during the
- 4 closing months of World War II in Cagayan de Oro, Mindanao, Philippines on
- 5 March 25, 1945; and
- 6 WHEREAS, the son of the village chief, Mr. Abaday was the middle child
- of twelve (12) children, he was raised on the family farm growing crops and
- 8 raising livestock; and
- 9 **WHEREAS**, after completing the sixth (6th) grade, Mr. Abaday took a
- 10 year off to work full-time on the family farm, yet he did not yield his
- 11 aspiration to continue his education; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Abaday attended Xavier University, Cagayan De Oro, 1 2 Philippines, where he graduated with a Bachelor's degree in 1969; and WHEREAS, Mr. Abaday was asked by the Jesuits to become a teaching 3 missionary in Belau after he graduated, which he accepted without 4 reservation; and 5 WHEREAS, during the nine (9) years he lived in Belau, Mr. Abaday 6 taught at Mindszenty High School, he often acted as the sacristan at the 7 8 church, he became fluent in the Belauan language, he wrote and directed an award winning play for his students ("Mother and Son" won first place in 9 1975), eventually becoming principal of Mindszenty High School in 1976; and 10 WHEREAS, in 1976, Mr. Abaday met his wife Roberta in Belau, a 11 mission teacher from the United States, they married in 1977, and for the next 12 thirty (30) years they would enjoy life to the fullest; and 13 WHEREAS, in 1978, Mr. Abaday left Belau to extend his education, he 14 earned a Master's in International Affairs with a concentration in Southeast 15 Asian from Ohio University, Athens, Ohio in 1979, and he obtained a Master's 16 in Political Science and a Certificate in Public Administration from Ohio 17 University in 1981; and 18 19 **WHEREAS**, in 1981, the Abadays moved to Guam, and Mr. Abaday began his teaching career on Guam at Father Duenas Memorial School; and 20 WHEREAS, in 1986, the Abadays left Guam briefly only to return in 21 1987 to work in the public school system; and 22 WHEREAS, Mr. Abaday was a teacher at Untalan Middle School from 1987 to 23 1988, he than taught at John F. Kennedy High School from 1988 to his untimely 24 25 passing; and

- 1 WHEREAS, Mr. Abaday's accomplishments were numerous, he
- 2 organized the mock trial program for the Department of Education; was co-
- 3 author of the social studies curriculum and performance standard for the
- 4 Department of Education, Guam Teacher of the year 2001 finalist, and more;
- 5 and
- 6 **WHEREAS,** his civic involvements were numerous, Mr. Abaday was on
- 7 the board of directors for the Guam Humanities Council, IRA membership
- 8 and Read-A-Thon committees, the Governor's Commission on Educational
- 9 Excellence, and others.
- 10 WHEREAS. Mr. Abaday's love of teaching and passion for Language
- 11 Arts and Social Studies have left a deep impression on the thousands of
- 12 students who have studied in his classroom since he began his pedagogic
- 13 career, and
- WHEREAS, the island community recognizes the contributions of the Mr.
- 15 Abaday in making sure the youth of Guam and Belau are educated and
- 16 productive members of society; and
- WHEREAS, Mr. Abaday has been bestowed with the honor of being one
- of Guam's premiere educators, by the Guam Chapter of the Phi Delta Kappa
- and is being inducted into the "Guam Educator's Hall of Fame,"; now,
- 20 therefore, be it
