

- 3 WHEREAS, Builder Senior Chief (Seabee Combat Warfare) Bear D.
- 4 McDaniel was born in Chattanooga, Tennessee on October 3, 1951; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Bear attended and graduated from Sterling College in
- 6 Sterling, Kansas in 1973 with a Bachelor of Science degree in Physical
- 7 Education and a minor in Secondary Education; and
- 8 WHEREAS, after several years of working in various civilian positions,
- 9 in 1983, Bear enlisted in the United States Navy under the delayed entry

1 program and began his active duty with Basic Training in Orlando, Florida;

WHEREAS, Bear attended Builder "A" School in Gulfport, Mississippi in 1984 as an Honor Graduate and shortly after graduation was assigned to CBU 415 in Oceana, Virginia where he advanced from BUCN to BU2 and was honored as the "Athlete of the Year" for Naval Air Station Oceana in 1985 and 1986 and was Seabee of the Quarter and Runner Up as Sailor of the Year in 1985; and

WHEREAS, from Oceana he was transferred to NCTC, Gulfport, Mississippi Builder C-1 Advance School and then to NMCB 62 in Gulfport. During this tour he was promoted to BU1 with deployments to Subic Bay, Philippines and to Guam and Tinian. In 1989 he was assigned to CBU 402 in Pensacola, Florida as Project Supervisor and Assistant Operations Chief, where he once again earned the title of Seabee of the Quarter and Seabee of the Year for 1990; and

WHEREAS, in September 1994, Bear D. McDaniel was promoted to the rank of Builder Chief Petty Officer, He was the Adak Naval Complex Search and Rescue Team Leader and an Active Search and Rescue Team member at the Naval Air Station Facility In Adak, Alaska. In August 1995, he was transferred to the Field Command Defense Nuclear Agency, which was a Joint Service Command located at Kirtland Air Force Base, New Mexico where he was selected as DNSWA Senior NCO of the Quarter and Test Director SNCO of the Year in the multi service command; and

WHEREAS, after several more assignments in places such as Kosovo,

- 1 Hawaii and Okinawa, Bear D. McDaniel reported to NAVFACMAR on Guam
- 2 in January 2005; and
- 3 WHEREAS, over the span of his Navy career he has earned awards
- 4 including; the Defense Meritorious Service Medal, Navy Achievement Medal
- 5 (Five Gold Stars), Joint Meritorious Unit Award (with Gold Cluster), Navy
- 6 Unit Commendation Medal, Navy "E" Ribbon, Navy Good Conduct Medal
- 7 (seven awards), National Defense Medal, Southwest Asia Medal (Bronze Star),
- 8 Global War on Terrorism Service Medal, Korean Defense Service Medal,
- 9 Kosovo Campaign Medal, Navy Sea Service Deployment Ribbon (four
- 10 Bronze Stars), Navy & Marine Corps Overseas Service Medal (seven awards),
- 11 NATO Medal, Kuwait Liberation Medal, Navy Rifle Expert Medal (four
- 12 awards), and Navy Pistol Sharpshooter Ribbon; and
- 13 WHEREAS, while on Guam, Bear has shared his knowledge gained
- through his experience in the U.S. Navy as the instructor of the OSHA Safety
- 15 Program at the Guam Community College, teaching over fifteen courses on
- 16 Safety; and
- 17 WHEREAS, Bear has worked with contractors on Guam to identify and
- 18 document safety violations with "Life Threatening Situations" and other
- 19 safety discrepancies with recommendations to correct them, resulting in safer
- 20 construction sites on Guam; and
- 21 **WHEREAS**, Bear has also shared his personal time to volunteer in many
- 22 worthwhile causes on island including Habitat for Humanity, Toys for Tots,
- 23 Salvation Army Christmas Boxes, and many other causes. He was awarded
- 24 the Guam Contractors Association Special Recognition Glass Latte Stone- For
