WHEREAS, Ms. Elaine Low, having moved to Guam with her family from Hong Kong, graduated from the Academy of Our Lady of Guam, received her Bachelors degree from the University of Washington and her Masters degree from Texas A&M University; and WHEREAS, Elaine and her husband of six years Edgardo Retumban are proud parents of two adorable children, five year-old Kenneth and two year-old Celestina; and

WHEREAS, Elaine has served as the Executive Director for the American Cancer Society for the past nine years and has been promoted to be the Regional Director of Development for the American Cancer Society Hawaii Pacific, Inc. and will be relocated with her family from Guam to Hawaii; and

WHEREAS, Elaine's dedication to the people and community of Guam has been seen

through her successful promotion of awareness and education of cancer though community involvement as she sought the support of the local community to fight cancer through the successful *Relay For Life*, an annual event dedicated to celebrating the lives of our local cancer survivors and reminding our community that our survivors are symbols of hope and proof that progress exists in the fight against cancer, which has grown from raising \$81,800 in 1999 to raising over \$340,000 in 2007; and

WHEREAS, Elaine's passion for improving the quality of life for our local cancer patients and their families led to many initiated programs through the training of volunteers that has provided support for our local cancer patients through programs such as *Reach to Recovery*, a support program for breast cancer survivors and newly diagnosed breast cancer patients and *Look Good Feel Better*, a program designed to help cancer patients cope with the appearance related to the side effects of cancer treatment and also by ensuring the provision of services through the patient services program; and

WHEREAS, Elaine hosted the first all day conference on breast cancer in 2000, with over 500 women in attendance and has also facilitated the increase of the cancer knowledge base of our local people by coordinating many learning opportunities, such as community cancer conferences, continuing education classes and lecture series for physicians and other health professionals, and extended the reach of the American Cancer Society to the young adults in our community as she assisted in preparing the foundation of Guam's first Colleges Against Cancer Chapter at the University of Guam; and

WHEREAS, Elaine's encouragement of our local leaders and stakeholders helped to form a collaborative effort to address Comprehensive Cancer Control for Guam and the development of Guam's first Comprehensive Cancer Control Plan which contributed to the development of the Regional Comprehensive Cancer Control Plan and the establishment of a Regional Cancer Registry that addresses the data collection needs of the region, covering the island in the Pacific Region; and

WHEREAS, Elaine's dedication to the community extended outside the sphere of cancer as she served as an active member of the Rotary Club of Northern Guam, having served as club service director and secretary, and spearheaded a student exchange program which allowed students from Japan and Guam to experience living in different cultures to deepen their understanding and respect for our neighbors; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that *I Mina' Bente Nuebi Na Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of the people of Guam, recognize and commend Ms. Elaine Low on her many accomplishments and dedication to cancer patients, survivors, and their families, most especially for her contributions to the people of Guam and the encouragement of community service and involvement through outreach activities; and be it further
