1 BE IT RESOLVED BY I MINA' BENTE NUEBI NA LIHESLATURAN
2 GUAHÅN:

3 WHEREAS, the Honorable Chang-son Kim, born on March 20, 1947, has
4 served as Consul General for the Korean Consulate Agency in Guam since
5 2005; and

6 WHEREAS, Consul General Kim was educated in Korea and later at the
7 prestigious M.I.T. in Boston, first earning his B.A. in Public Administration
8 from Youngnam University, his M.A. in Public Administration from Seoul
9 National University and later attending a Special Program on Urban and
10 Regional Studies at M.I.T.; and

11 WHEREAS, Consul General Kim has served in many important
12 positions in government agencies and prestigious organizations: Assistant
13 Director, Public Enterprise Budgeting, Economic Planning Board; Director,
14 Seoul Olympic Organizing Committee; Director, Multinational Economic
15 Cooperation, Economic Planning Board; as Visiting Scholar, Hoover

1 Institution, Stanford University; Director, Multilateral Trade, Ministry of
2 Finance and Economy; Deputy Director General, APEC Trade & Investment,
3 Ministry of Foreign Affairs & Trade (MOFAT); Deputy Consul General,
4 Korean Consulate General in Houston; Deputy Director-General, Multilateral
5 Trade Bureau, MOFAT; and Deputy Consul General, Korean Consulate
6 General in Hong Kong; and

7 **WHEREAS**, Consul General Kim has furthered human knowledge with
8 a number of publications, including: Political Economy of Distribution (1990);
9 Toward Cultural Capitalism (1995); and Service Advantage in the Open
10 Markets (2002); and

11 **WHEREAS**, Consul General Kim has earned a number of very
12 prestigious and honorable distinctions, including: President's Letter of
13 Commendation (1977); Medal of Public Service (1986); and Deputy Prime
14 Minister's Letter of Commendation (1994); and

15 **WHEREAS**, Consul General Kim and his wife and son have made
16 Guam their home over the last two years, serving both the people of Korea
17 and the people of Guam admirably; and

18 **WHEREAS**, Consul General Kim has been extremely involved and
19 supportive of the Korean community of Guam, including the Korean
20 Association of Guam, Korean Women's Association of Guam, and the Korean
21 Amateur Sports Association of Guam; and

22 **WHEREAS**, Consul General Kim has endeavored to establish the
23 Korean Chamber of Commerce to foster a growth in Korean businesses on
24 Guam, to promote trade and investment between the two regions, and to

1 establish a good relationship between the Korean business community and
2 the rest of the local community; and

3 **WHEREAS**, Consul General Kim has done a tremendous job in
4 promoting Guam as a tourism destination, helping the Guam Visitors Bureau
5 to increase the number of Korean visitors to Guam and helping promote the
6 safe travel of tourists while on Guam; and

7 **WHEREAS**, Consul General Kim has worked with community leaders
8 and members of the Korean associations on Guam to emphasize a good
9 Korean community that has a long history on Guam, that increases the
10 diversity of cultures on Guam, and that develops a good relationship between
11 the local community and the Korean community on Guam; and

12 **WHEREAS**, Consul General Kim has been a strong part of the Catholic
13 community on Guam, serving as a catechist with the Korean Catholic church
14 and also attending masses at the Cathedral Basilica in Hagatna; now,
15 therefore be it

16 **RESOLVED**, that *I Mina 'Bente Nuebi na Liheslaturan Guåhan* on behalf of
17 the people of Guam does hereby express its sincere gratitude to Consul
18 General Chang-son Kim for his service on Guam and wishes him and his
19 family the best of luck in all future endeavors; and be it further

21 Legislature attest to, the adoption hereof, and that copies of the same be
