- WHEREAS, the Jose D. Leon Guerrero Port Authority was established as a public corporation and autonomous government agency on
- 5 October 1975; and

- WHEREAS, over the last three decades, our Port has provided full services to ocean passenger, cargo and fishing vessels who have called upon our seaport and has developed into a major transshipment center for the
- 9 Western Pacific; and
- WHEREAS, the Port is the lifeline to our island and critical to our country's national security. It is essential for the continued development of our economy and the survival of the people of Guam due to our dependence on imported goods including food, fuel, medical supplies, equipment and raw materials;

WHEREAS, in 2006, the Port moved about two million (2,000,000) revenue tons of cargo and about seventy eight thousand, two hundred twenty one (78,221) containers; and

WHEREAS, the three hundred twenty-five (325) dedicated and hardworking employees handle port operations as stevedores, cargo checkers, equipment operators, accountants, tariff specialists and managers for the five (5) cargo handling piers, a container yard, two (2) fuel piers, three (3) marinas and a harbor of refuge; and

WHEREAS, our Port services ships from around the world, over four hundred (400) cargo vessels and more than seven hundred fifty (750) foreign-flagged fishing vessels annually; and

WHEREAS, despite its aging equipment, the Port has successfully completed the annual Occupational Safety and Health Administration inspection of all of its cargo handling equipment; and

WHEREAS, over the past Fiscal Year, the Port has made significant progress through the purchase of a 40 ton used mobile harbor crane, the issuance of an Invitation for Bid for one new dockside container handling gantry crane with the option of a second crane, and the Invitation for Bid for the replacement of chain link fence with concrete masonry unit wall within the port compound;

WHEREAS, the Port has retained the consulting services of Parsons Brinkerhoff International to update its Master Plan serving as the road map for short term and long term plans for infrastructure development,

- 1 equipment acquisition, facility upgrades, and financing options in
- 2 preparation of the military buildup and beyond;
- WHEREAS, the Port received \$1 million dollars in federal grant
- 4 monies to complete the Port's Comprehensive Vulnerability Assessment, for
- 5 the construction of a CMU wall for the northern perimeter of the container
- 6 yard, and for the acquisition of security screen equipment;
- WHEREAS, the Port completed the repairs and upgrades to F1 fuel
- 8 pier, fully restoring one of the Port's two main fuel piers;
- 9 WHEREAS, the Port stands ready to face the challenges ahead,
- including the upcoming military build up for the relocation of 8,000 marines,
- their families and support services; and
- WHEREAS, during "National Port Week", from October 22, 2007
- 13 through October 26, 2007, our port will conduct a public awareness
- 14 campaign which highlights the economic benefits gained from the port's
- operations and their outstanding contributions towards the development of
- our island; now, therefore, be it
