1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY I MINA'BENTE NUEBI NA LIHESLATURAN**
2 **GUĀHAN:**

1 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Vicente “Vic” S. Angoco, Jr. is the eldest of three (3)
2 brothers and one (1) sister born to Vicente S. Angoco, Sr. and Norma Godinet
3 Angoco in *Hagåtña, Guam*; and

4 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Vic Angoco married Evelyn Estano on January 9, 1999
5 and have been blessed with three (3) sons -- Nicholas Austin and Connor; and

6 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Vic Angoco attended public elementary and junior
7 high school on Guam; graduated from Father Dueñas Memorial High School
8 in 1984; and earned a Bachelor’s degree in Business Management from Oregon
9 State University, Portland, Oregon in 1989; and

10 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Vic Angoco entered the shipping industry in 1990,
11 joining Sea-Land Services, Inc., Guam as a Marine Coordinator with the
12 responsibility of planning the discharge and loading of vessels as they came
13 into port each week. In 1991, he was promoted to Operations Manager,
14 responsible for vessel and container yard operations; and

15 **WHEREAS**, prior to joining Matson, Mr. Angoco was employed for four
16 (4) years with American President Lines, Ltd (APL) as the Marine Manager
17 and later becoming the Operations and Logistics Manager that same year. He
18 had overall responsibility for operations in Guam, the Commonwealth of the
19 Northern Mariana Islands (CNMI) and in Micronesia; and

20 **WHEREAS**, in February 1996, with Matson Navigation Company, Inc.
21 taking over the APL operations in Guam and Micronesia, Mr. Angoco joined
22 Matson as Manager, Operations, Guam and soon thereafter was promoted to
23 Manager, Sales and Customer Service Manager for the region. His knowledge

1 of Matson's customers in Guam, as well as the company's operations, made
2 him particularly effective in managing the area's sales and customer service
3 activities; and

4 **WHEREAS**, as part of a management development program, Mr.
5 Angoco was transferred to Matson's headquarters in San Francisco in 2001 to
6 become the Eastern Region Sales Manager. His areas of responsibility covered
7 the entire area from the Rocky Mountains to the East Coast, calling on major
8 accounts such as Kmart, Wal-Mart, Anheuser-Busch, General Motors and
9 Ford Motor Company, to name a few. He received a Presidential Award that
10 year for his performance in that position; and

11 **WHEREAS**, in June 2002, Mr. Angoco was then transferred to Honolulu,
12 Hawaii where he became the Container Operations Manager on Sand Island,
13 Matson's largest terminal operation. He was responsible for coordinating
14 cargo operations with the terminal operator to ensure cargo off the four (4)
15 weekly ships was discharged efficiently and timely to meet the needs of the
16 customers on Oahu and to meet the sailings of the three (3) Matson barges to
17 all the Neighbor Islands; and

18 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Angoco joined a local tug and barge operator, Young
19 Brothers, Limited, as the Vice President of Sales in August 2004. Young
20 Brothers operates six (6) tugs and eleven (11) barges providing twenty (20) to
21 twenty-two (22) sailings a week between Honolulu and the Neighbor Islands.
22 In April of 2005, he was promoted to Vice-President and General Manager of

1 Young Brothers, responsible for the overall operations throughout the State of
2 Hawaii; and

3 **WHEREAS**, on December 26, 2006, Mr. Angoco returned to Matson
4 Navigation, Guam and was promoted to Senior Vice President and later that
5 year, Mr. Angoco assumed the position of General Manager for Guam and
6 Micronesia; and

7 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Angoco was an active member of our community,
8 serving with the Rotary Club of Northern Guam, Junior Achievement and is a
9 member of the Rotary Club of Guam, the Bookmobile Foundation and the
10 Mount Carmel Endowment Foundation; and

11 **WHEREAS**, in his personal and professional life, Mr. Vic Angoco has
12 constantly stressed integrity and respect for others and has served as a source
13 of inspiration to his colleagues, friends and family, to whom he has always
14 encouraged personal and professional growth; and

15 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Vic Angoco, originally from Guam, has been in the
16 maritime industry since 1990, including thirteen (13) years in operations and
17 sales management positions in Guam; now, therefore, be it


18 **RESOLVED**, that *I Mina'Bente Nuebe Na Liheslaturan Guåhan* does
