GMH is 19 20 presently certified by the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services 21 (CMMS), formally known as the Health Care Financing Administration (HCFA); its Laboratory is accredited by the College of American Pathologists 22 23 (CAP); and its mammography machine is certified by the American College of 24 Radiology; and
