3        **WHEREAS**, National Police Week will be celebrated nationwide from  
4 May 11 to 17, 2008, as a tribute to the men and women of law enforcement

1 who protect our communities; and

2       **WHEREAS**, the brave personnel of the Guam Police Department, the  
3 Port Authority of Guam Police, and the Antonio B. Won Pat Guam  
4 International Airport Authority Police enforce the laws of our island every  
5 day, placing their lives at risk to defend our citizens; and

6       **WHEREAS**, with the mounting number of crimes in our community,  
7 our police officers serve numerous increased hours sacrificing their time for  
8 the welfare of others; and

9       **WHEREAS**, these courageous men and women work with the civilian  
10 personnel who perform essential functions in support of uniformed officers;  
11 and

12       **WHEREAS**, many of Guam’s police and peace officers have died in the  
13 line of duty, the ultimate act of selflessness that will be remembered at the  
14 *Hagåtña* Police Memorial Monument on “**Peace Officer’s Memorial Day**”,  
15 May 15, 2008; and

16       **WHEREAS**, men and women of law enforcement, including those who  
17 are retired, deserve public recognition for their unparalleled service to the  
18 people of Guam; now, therefore, be it

19       **RESOLVED**, that *I Mina'Bente Nuebi Na Liheslaturan Guåhan* does  
20 hereby, on behalf of the people of Guam, recognize and commend the men  
21 and women of the Guam Police Department, the Port Authority of Guam  
22 Police, and the Antonio B. Won Pat Guam International Airport Authority  
23 Police for their dedication, courage, and professionalism; and be it further

1           **RESOLVED**, that *I Mina'Bente Nuebi Na Liheslaturan Guåhan* does  
2 hereby, on behalf of the people of Guam, recognize the week of May 11 to  
3 May 17, 2008, as "Guam Police Week" and encourages the island to celebrate,  
4 with uniformed and civilian members of the Guam Police Department, the  
5 Port Authority of Guam Police, and the Antonio B. Won Pat Guam  
6 International Airport Authority Police, in programs designed to encourage the  
7 adherence to law, to promote public safety, and to pay tribute to the brave  
8 police officers and peace officers of Guam and the nation who have given so  
9 much to preserve the life and property through the fair and efficient  
10 enforcement of law; and be it further

12 Legislature attest to, the adoption hereof, and that copies of the same be  
13 thereafter transmitted to Colonel Joaquin G. Reyes, Chairperson of the 2008,

15 Castro, Chairperson of the 2008 Guam Police Week Committee; to Mr. Paul R.  
16 Suba, Chief of Police, Guam Police Department; to Ms. Doris C. Aguero,  
17 Chief, Port Authority of Guam Police; to Mr. Patrick A. Fejeran, Acting Chief,  
18 Antonio B. Won Pat Guam International Airport Authority, Airport Police;  
19 and to the Honorable Felix P. Camacho, *I Maga'lahren Guåhan*.
