2 Individual, Marriage and Family Therapists; and


3 **WHEREAS**, as a member of the Board of Allied Health Examiners, Dr.

14 further


15 **RESOLVED**, that *I Mina'Bente Nuebi Na Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby
