3        **WHEREAS, Mr. Kevin C. Masnayan, the third son of six (6) boys and**  
4 **six (6) girls of Mr. Ricardo P. and the late Mrs. Soledad Masnayan, was born**

1 on June 7, 1965 in Guam; and

2       **WHEREAS**, Mr. Kevin C. Masnayon is married to the former Maria  
3 Polk, daughter of Mr. James Polk and the late Mrs. Roquita Camacho, on  
4 April 11, 2005; and

5       **WHEREAS**, Mr. Kevin C. and Mrs. Maria Polk Masnayon are residents  
6 of Agaña Heights, Guam, and have been blessed with four (4) children:  
7 Michael T. P. Sablan, age 19; Mason P. P. Sablan, age 16; Kevin Jr., age 17; and  
8 Chelsee, age 13; and

9       **WHEREAS**, Mr. Masnayon's father, being a softball player from the  
10 Philippines, playing for the Camp Roxas, Masdelco team and the family  
11 'sresidence located right behind the Agaña Heights baseball field, he and his  
12 siblings grew up playing baseball and softball; and

13       **WHEREAS**, growing up seeing softball and baseball games being  
14 cancelled due to the lack of umpires and experiencing numerous  
15 disappointments because of the cancellations, Mr. Kevin C. Masnayon, at a  
16 very early age, decided to learn the trade of umpiring with the hope of giving  
17 back to the community; and

18       **WHEREAS**, Mr. Masnayon's decision, desire and perseverance to learn  
19 the trade of umpiring allows for all players, young and old, to continue  
20 enjoying the sport that he has grown to love; and

21       **WHEREAS**, Mr. Kevin C. Masnayon received his General Education  
22 from the Guam Community College in 2007; worked as a Security Supervisor  
23 at the Pacific Star Hotel for eight (8) years; and twelve (12) years working at  
24 the Agaña Heights Mayor's Office; and

1           **WHEREAS**, Mr. Masnayon has thirteen (13) years of umpiring  
2 experience with the Guam Little League, the Junior, Senior and Big Leagues in  
3 both the regular seasons and during regional tournaments. He also umpired  
4 for the Budweiser Baseball League (former Guam Major League), the Guam  
5 Masters Baseball League, and the occasional softball games; and

6           **WHEREAS**, major achievements accomplished by Mr. Masnayon  
7 include, being an umpire at the Senior League World Series in Bangor, Maine  
8 in 2004, and his most recent selection to umpire the 2008 Little League World  
9 Series in Williamsport, Pennsylvania. Mr. Masnayon also enjoys playing  
10 softball and baseball, dancing, singing and our island's favorite past-time -  
11 Bar-B-Ques; and

12           **WHEREAS**, Mr. Kevin C. Masnayon has also spent much of his time  
13 actively helping the people of Guam through his contributions in numerous  
14 civic, community, and religious activities; now, therefore, be it
