3           **WHEREAS**, CTSI Logistics had their beginnings in 1989 as Consolidated  
4 Transportation Services Inc., the freight forwarding arm of its parent  
5 company, Tan Holdings, servicing Guam, the Northern Marianas, and  
6 Micronesia; and

7           **WHEREAS**, in 1991, CTSI built their first warehousing facility in Guam  
8 for consolidated freight service operations, and for several years focused on  
9 freight forwarding, as well as on the growing businesses within the Pacific  
10 islands, giving CTSI solid experience in cargo consolidation, as well as  
11 building a loyal client base for the business; and

12           **WHEREAS**, in 1995, CTSI opened an office at the Antonio B. Won Pat  
13 International Airport to better serve its growing list of customers; and in 1997  
14 CTSI became an agent for foreign shipping line, Mariana Express Lines, Ltd.  
15 (MELL), opening an office at the Jose D. Leon Guerrero Commercial Port; and

16           **WHEREAS**, the rapid expansion and globalization of businesses in the  
17 1990s helped CTSI take its services to the next level, bringing on board a  
18 young and dynamic team of Information Technology and Logistics  
19 professionals who helped the company evolve into an integrated logistics  
20 provider, subsequently re-naming itself CTSI Logistics; and

21           **WHEREAS**, with its broad knowledge of the industry, strong  
22 information technology expertise, and specialized customer service, CTSI is

1 providing air freight service capabilities and on-land service requirements,  
2 including, trucking, warehouse management and storage, in addition to its  
3 ocean freight services; and

4       **WHEREAS**, CTSI Logistics now encompasses twenty-seven (27) stations  
5 in twelve (12) countries across North America, Asia and the Pacific, stretching  
6 from Vietnam to New York City; and

7       **WHEREAS**, CTSI's current operation in Guam continues its growth and  
8 expansion, with the groundbreaking of a new Airport Facility Warehouse to  
9 take place at the Won Pat International Airport on December 18, 2008; and

10       **WHEREAS**, this new facility, especially during a time when economies  
11 worldwide are experiencing a slowdown, demonstrates CTSI Logistics'  
12 commitment to our island and our people; now, therefore, be it


13       **RESOLVED**, that *I Mina'Bente Nuebi Na Liheslaturan Guåhan* does

2 owners, management, and staff; and be it further


3 **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker certify, and the Secretary of the
