WHEREAS, Mrs. Isabel Sanchez Rivera ("Beck"), of Barrigada, who

3 WHEREAS, Mrs. Rivera was married in 1938 to Ignacio San Nicolas 4 Rivera and they had three (3) children: Francisco Sanchez Rivera, who was employed at the Department of Public Works and who passed away 5 December 22, 1999; Josephine Rivera Mesa, who retired from the Department 6 of Mental Health and Substance Abuse after twenty-six (26) years of service; 7 and Mildred Rivera Camacho, currently a Budget Analyst for the Federal 8 Government, who worked at the Navy Public Works Center for 9 approximately thirty-nine (39) years; and 10

WHEREAS, Mrs. Rivera has twelve (12) grandchildren; eighteen (18)
 great grandchildren; and two (2) great-great grandchildren; and her
 immediate family contains three (3) generations of public service to Guam; and
 WHEREAS, Mrs. Rivera received her teaching degree from the
 Territorial College of Guam in 1959; and

WHEREAS, Mrs. Rivera served as a teacher from 1934 to 1975, and
taught at many island schools including Padre Palomo Elementary School in
pre-war times, *Sumai* Elementary School, Piti Elementary School, Chalan Pago
Elementary School, Maria Ulloa Elementary School, Tamuning Elementary
School, Barrigada Elementary School, and Mongmong Elementary School; and
WHEREAS, Mrs. Rivera received a number of awards, including the
"Fiftieth (50th) Anniversary Year of the Organic Act 'Pride in our Progress'

Award" on August 1, 2000 honoring families with generations in public
 service; and the "Fortieth (40th) Year Service Medal Pin Award"; and
