1        **BE IT RESOLVED BY *I MINA'BENTE NUEBI NA LIHESLATURAN***  
2 ***GUÅHAN*:**

3        **WHEREAS**, National Police Week will be celebrated nationwide from  
4 May 13 to 19, 2007 as a tribute to the men and women of law enforcement  
5 who protect our communities; and

1           **WHEREAS**, the brave personnel of the Guam Police Department, Port  
2 Authority of Guam Police, and the A.B. Won Pat Guam International Airport  
3 Authority Police enforce the laws of our island every day, placing their lives  
4 at risk to defend our citizens; and

5           **WHEREAS**, with the mounting number of crimes in our community,  
6 our police officers serve numerous increased hours sacrificing their time for  
7 the welfare of others; and

8           **WHEREAS**, these courageous men and women, work with the civilian  
9 personnel who perform essential functions in support of uniformed officers;  
10 and

11           **WHEREAS**, many of Guam’s police and peace officers, have died in the  
12 line of duty, the ultimate act of selflessness that will be remembered at the  
13 *Hagåtña* Police Memorial Monument on “Peace Officer’s Memorial Day” May  
14 15, 2007; and

15           **WHEREAS**, men and women of law enforcement, including those who  
16 are retired, deserve public recognition for their unparalleled service to the  
17 people of Guam; now, therefore, be it

18           **RESOLVED**, that *I Mina’Bente Nuebi Na Liheslaturan Guåhan* does  
19 hereby, on behalf of the people of Guam, recognize and commend the men  
20 and women of the Guam Police Department, Port Authority of Guam Police,  
21 and the A. B. Won Pat Guam International Airport Authority Police for their  
22 dedication, courage, and professionalism; and be it further

23           **RESOLVED**, that *I Mina’Bente Nuebi Na Liheslaturan Guåhan* does  
24 hereby, on behalf of the people of Guam, recognizes the week of May 13  
25 through May 19, 2007 as “Guam Police Week” and encourages the island to

1 celebrate, with uniformed and civilian members of the Guam Police  
2 Department, the Port Authority of Guam Police, and the A. B. Won Pat Guam  
3 International Airport Authority Police, in programs designed to encourage the  
4 adherence to law, to promote public safety, and to pay tribute to the brave  
5 police officers and peace officers of Guam and the nation who have given so  
6 much to preserve the life and property through the fair and efficient  
7 enforcement of law; and be it further
