3 **WHEREAS,** Carmen Paulino Bermudes was born April 19, 1947, and
4 recently celebrated her sixieth (60th) birthday. She is the daughter of Vicente
5 D. Paulino (deceased) and Floren Paulino. She is one of three (3) siblings, the

1 other two (2) being Benny Paulino and Florence Shimizu. She has five (5)
2 children: Florina Bermudes, Tanya Cruz, Vince Bermudes, James Bermudes,
3 and Carmen Renee Taitague, and is the grandmother of three (3) Joshua,
4 Carmae and Ayden; and

5 **WHEREAS**, Carmen Paulino Bermudes is a 1965 graduate of the
6 Academy of Our Lady of Guam. She obtained a Bachelor's Degree in
7 Education from the University of Guam in 1985, and continues to take courses
8 in continuing education for her self-development and certification. Carmen
9 Paulino Bermudes has been an educator for nineteen (19) years. She chaired
10 and represented Oceanview Middle School "Read-A-Thon Week" for her
11 efforts and teamwork. She received one of seven (7) "Week of the Classroom
12 Teacher" awards and was recently selected the "Top Secondary Read-a-thon
13 Teacher Representative", and will be attending the Annual Convention in
14 Toronto, Canada, coordinated by the International Reading Association (IRA);

16 **WHEREAS**, prior to teaching in Guam, Carmen was an instructor in the
17 Philippines for the Department of Defense (DOD) and at St. Philomena
18 Catholic Day Care Center in Honolulu, Hawaii. She was employed as a
19 Security Guard for Duty Free Shop in the Honolulu Airport; and

21 the Malojloj *San Isidro* Parish Association. She was the first woman President
22 to serve twice and volunteered as the Director of Religious Education for

2 demonstrates her energetic humanitarian spirit and generosity through her
3 donating time to her parish, community, and government projects; now,
4 therefore, be it


5 **RESOLVED**, that *I Mina’Bente Nuebi Na Liheslaturan Guåhan* does
