3 WHEREAS, the late Army Major Henry San Nicolas Ofeciar was born

4 on July 5, 1970 to his proud parents, Pedro Ofeciar, Agnes San Nicolas Rillera,

5 and Leonard Mendiola Rillera, was called to his eternal reward on August 27,

6 2007 at the age of thirty seven (37) years; and

WHEREAS, the U. S. Army relates that Major Henry San Nicolas
 Ofeciar died from injuries sustained in an attack in Jalalabad as a result of
 small arms fire and RPGs; and

WHEREAS, those who knew him best describe "Hank", Ofeciar as 4 officer and a gentleman. Since his passing, the countless recollections about 5 the man heard at I Liheslatura describe a happy person and proud islander, 6 dedicated to his family, his friends, his country and his homeland. When our 7 nation needed him to serve, "Hank" knew without hesitation that it was an 8 obligation to serve his country in the armed forces he so loved and cherished. 9 10 Hank knew that freedom was not free, numerous soldiers before him had paid the ultimate price so that we could enjoy the freedom that we all 11 12 sometimes take for granted; and

WHEREAS, Hank's easy-going, playful nature co-existed with the heart of a true soldier. Having received his commission from the Army in 1993 after graduating from the University of Guam, Hank earned a Master's Degree in Finance from Syracuse University. His duties posted him all over the world, most recently with the formidable 1st Infantry Division out of Fort Riley, Kansas; and

WHEREAS, in the words of Major General Donald Goldhorn, Adjutant
General of the Guam National Guard, "Major Ofeciar served with flawless
distinction as a leader of a dedicated training team responsible for working
with the Afghan Police; and

WHEREAS, Major Ofeciar was many things to those people who had
the privilege of knowing him, he was a jokester, confidant, steadfast listener,

and the type of person who would call you out of the blue and welcome you,
 even after years of being away; and

WHEREAS, the history he helped to forge and the flag he gave his life to defend do not shield the pain felt by those he leaves behind. His parents, in-laws, and scores of acquaintances shed tears, both for the man that's no longer with us, but also with pride for the manner in which he gave his life; and

8 WHEREAS, I Mina'Bente Nuebi Na Liheslaturan Guåhan, together with I Maga'lahen Guåhan, on behalf of a truly grateful people, honor the life of a hero 9 and welcome home our brother, Major Henry San Nicolas Ofeciar, a man of 10 11 faith, courage and conviction. A man of honor. To his family, friends and all 12 those whose lives were touched by Major Henry San Nicolas Ofeciar, I Mina'Bente Nuebi Na Liheslaturan Guåhan, together with I Maga'lahen Guåhan, 13 want you to know that the people of Guam stand with you as we remember 14 the life and the legacy of this brave soldier. Please accept our sincerest 15 condolences, our deepest gratitude and our support during this very difficult 16 17 time; now, therefore, be it

18 **RESOLVED,** that *I Mina'Bente Nuebi Na Liheslaturan Guåhan* joins our 19 island community to pay tribute to the late Army Major Henry San Nicolas 20 Ofeciar, an outstanding young man who loved America who now becomes 21 one of America's heroes. Army Major Henry San Nicolas Ofeciar will forever 22 be remembered in the minds and hearts of his parents, siblings, his family at 23 the Guam Army National Guard and the people of Guam; and be it further

hereby, on behalf of the people of Guam, remember Army Major Henry San

Nicolas Ofeciar for his unselfish service to the United States of America and
