1        **BE IT RESOLVED BY I MINA'BENTE ÑUEBI NA LIHESLATURAN**  
2 **GUÅHAN:**

3        **WHEREAS,** the Honorable Chang-son Kim, Korean Consul General,  
4 born on March 20, 1947, has served as Consul General for the Korean  
5 Consulate Agency in Guam since 2005; and

6        **WHEREAS,** Consul General Kim was educated in Korea and later at the  
7 prestigious M.I.T. in Boston, first earning his B.A. in Public Administration

1 from Youngnam University, his M.A. in Public Administration from Seoul  
2 National University, and later attending a Special Program on Urban and  
3 Regional Studies at M.I.T.; and

4       **WHEREAS**, Consul General Kim has served in many important  
5 positions in government agencies and prestigious organizations: Assistant  
6 Director, Public Enterprise Budgeting, Economic Planning Board; Director,  
7 Seoul Olympic Organizing Committee; Director, Multinational Economic  
8 Cooperation, Economic Planning Board; Visiting Scholar, Hoover Institute,  
9 Stanford University; Director, Multilateral Trade, Ministry of Finance and  
10 Economy; Deputy Director General, APEC Trade & Investment, Ministry of  
11 Foreign Affairs & Trade (MOFAT); Deputy Consul General, Korean Consulate  
12 General in Houston; Deputy Director-General, Multilateral Trade Bureau,  
13 MOFAT; and Deputy Consul General, Korean Consulate General in Hong  
14 Kong; and

15       **WHEREAS**, Consul General Kim has furthered human knowledge with  
16 a number of publications, including: Political Economy of Distribution (1990);  
17 Toward Cultural Capitalism (1995); and Service Advantage in the Open  
18 Markets (2002); and

19       **WHEREAS**, Consul General Kim has earned a number of very  
20 prestigious and honorable distinctions, including: President's Letter of  
21 Commendation (1977); Medal of Public Service (1986); and Deputy Prime  
22 Minister's Letter of Commendation (1994); and

23       **WHEREAS**, Consul General Kim and his wife and son have made  
24 Guam their home over the last two (2) years, serving both the people of Korea  
25 and the people of Guam admirably; and

1           **WHEREAS**, Consul General Kim has been extremely supportive of the  
2 Korean community of Guam, including the Korean Association of Guam,  
3 Korean Women’s Association of Guam and the Korean Amateur Sports  
4 Association of Guam; and

5           **WHEREAS**, Consul General Kim has endeavored to establish the  
6 Korean Chamber of Commerce to foster growth in Korean businesses on  
7 Guam, to promote trade and investment between the two (2) regions and to  
8 establish a good relationship between the Korean business community and  
9 the rest of the local community; and

10          **WHEREAS**, Consul General Kim has done a tremendous job in  
11 promoting Guam as a tourism destination, helping the Guam Visitors Bureau  
12 increase the number of Korean visitors to Guam and helping promote the safe  
13 travel of tourists while on Guam; and

14          **WHEREAS**, Consul General Kim has worked with community leaders  
15 and the Korean Associations on Guam to advance a local Korean community  
16 that has a long history, that increases the diversity of local culture and that  
17 develops friendship between local residents and the Korean community; and


18          **WHEREAS**, Consul General Kim has been a strong member of the  
19 Catholic Church on Guam, serving as a catechist with the Korean Catholic  
20 church and attending masses at the Cathedral Basilica in *Hagåtña*; now,  
21 therefore, be it

1           **RESOLVED**, that *I Mina'Bente Ñuebi Na Liheslaturan Guåhan* does  
2 hereby, on behalf of the people of Guam, express its sincere gratitude to  
3 Korean Consul General Chang-son Kim for his service on Guam and wishes  
4 him and his family the best of luck in all future endeavors; and be it further

5           **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker certify, and the Secretary of the  
6 Legislature attest to, the adoption hereof, and that copies of the same be  
7 thereafter transmitted to the Honorable Chang-son Kim, Korean Consul  
8 General; and to the Honorable Felix P. Camacho, *I Maga'lahaen Guåhan*.
