3 **WHEREAS**, Darlene V. Unpingco, born on September 20, 1943, started
4 her career with the government of Guam in the 1970's as a General Helper;
5 and

6 **WHEREAS**, always wanting to better herself, Darlene V. Unpingco
7 worked diligently as an Assistance Payment Worker II in 1984 and in 1985

1 was promoted to Assistant Payment Worker III; she then served as an
2 Eligibility Specialist Supervisor from November 1985 to November 1992; and

3 **WHEREAS**, from October 1993 to September 1997, Darlene V. Unpingco
4 was a Program Coordinator II, and from January 1998 to February 2006 served
5 as Program Coordinator III; and

6 **WHEREAS**, Darlene, who was affectionately referred to by many of her
7 colleagues and friends as "*Mama*", frequently helped others carry out their
8 responsibilities, often sacrificing her own personal needs, desires and family
9 time; and

10 **WHEREAS**, Darlene V. Unpingco was nominated for "Supervisor of the
11 Year" in 1993 because of her effectiveness in locating and clearing applications
12 in the Document Intake Processing System (DIPS) Report in the Northern and
13 Southern Districts; and

14 **WHEREAS**, in Fiscal Year 2000, Darlene V. Unpingco was nominated
15 for the Top Seven (7) Employees of the Year because she voluntarily assisted
16 in times of crisis and worked beyond normal hours without additional
17 compensation. She performed tasks promptly, required little or no
18 supervision, accepted additional responsibilities, has and always maintained
19 good rapport with co-workers, management, and the public; and


20 **WHEREAS**, "*Mama*" helped make the Certification Section of the DPW
21 "Unit of the Year" for FY 1988 and was voted "Manager of the Year 1988". In
22 September 1991, 1992, 1997, and 2000, she received an award for "Outstanding
23 Performance"; and

1 **WHEREAS**, during the aftermath of Typhoons *Paka* and *Chata'an*
2 "*Mana*" volunteered her time and worked with the Emergency Disaster Food
3 Stamp Assistance Distribution; now, therefore, be it


4 **RESOLVED**, that *I Mina'Bente Nuebi Na Liheslaturan Guåhan* does
