AN ACT TO ADD A NEW §849.4 TO CHAPTER 8 OF TITLE 1 OF THE GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, TO RENAME THE MERIZO LIBRARY TO BE THE "ROSA AGUIGUI REYES MEMORIAL LIBRARY".

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

- Section 1. A new §849.4 is hereby *added* to Chapter 8 of Title 1 of the Guam Code Annotated, to read:
- "\$849.4. (a) Rosa Aguigui Reyes was the first woman elected to the Guam Congress, in 1946. She was a pioneer in politics, and in education. Her long career as an educator started in 1933, when she became a classroom teacher at Merizo Martyrs Elementary School in Merizo, a position she kept for

thirty-one (31) years. She was also a principal at F.Q. Sanchez School in Umatac for eleven (11) years. Mrs. Reyes was also a research assistant for noted anthropologist, Laura Thompson, for studies of Guam history and culture. She was part of the first commencement class of the College of Guam in 1954, earning an Associates Degree in Education, and was inducted into the "Educators Hall of Fame" in 1983. As an educational leader on Guam, Mrs. Reyes is a role model for young people today. By looking at her life and accomplishments, students of today can be inspired to high achievements. It is appropriate that a fitting honor be bestowed upon her memory.

(b) The Merizo Library is hereby named the "Rosa Aguigui Reyes Memorial Library." *I Maga'lahi shall* arrange an appropriate ceremony and signage to designate the library by this name".
