AN ACT TO ZONE THE PREVIOUSLY UNZONED LOT NUMBER 5327 IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF DEDEDO TO LIGHT INDUSTRIAL (M-1) ZONE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

- 2 Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent. I Liheslaturan Guåhan finds that
- 3 Lot Number 5327, in the Municipality of Dededo, which belonged to the Estate of Pablo
- 4 Sanchez was deeded back to the family by the Guam Ancestral Lands Commission,
- 5 pursuant to Public Law Nos. 22-145, 23-23, 23-141, 25-45, 25-178, 26-36 and 26-100,
- 6 which requires that excess federal properties turned over to the government of Guam then
- 7 be transferred over to the estates of the original landowners pursuant to Public Law No.
- 8 25-145.

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This parcel is on the frontage of the north-east side of Route 3, referred to as Ukudu, Dededo. The frontage area is comprised of Agricultural (A) and Light Industrial (M-1) zone. The property was purchased from the Estate of Pablo Sanchez and is now owned by Valeo, Inc., and the owner is developing a business that requires an M-1 zone designation.

Without an existing zone designation, the Guam Land Use Commission is unable to act on this matter. Authority to establish a comprehensive zoning plan for Ancestral Lands Commission properties, including those released by the Commission to original landowners, lies exclusively with the Provisional Commission for the Zoning of Ancestral Lands. Said Commission *has not* been empanelled since the enactment of Public Law No. 28-133, leaving the landowner with *no* recourse other than to request *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* to establish an appropriate zone for Lot Number 5327 in the municipality of Dededo.

Section 2. Lot Zoning. Notwithstanding any provision of the Law, Lot Number 5327 in the Municipality of Dededo is hereby zoned Light Industrial (M-1) Zone.
