This memorandum is being issued to notify you that the Office of the Public Auditor is required by law to provide notice to all directors of their responsibilities pursuant to Public Law (P.L.) 29-113, the *FY 2009 Budget Act*, passed in September 2008.

Please submit a "nil" report if you believe one or more of the reporting requirements are not applicable to your entity.

We also recommend the posting of the transmittal letter(s) with the receipt acknowledgement from the Speaker's office, as well as a copy of the electronic submission, on your website.

For your convenience, we have enclosed your department/agency's reporting requirements. Please review these as well as the FY 2009 Budget Act to ensure that you are aware of all your requirements. Failure to comply with any of the reporting requirements will result in a 20% salary reduction for you, your deputy and your Chief Financial Officer. You may also view the reporting requirements at our website, <u>www.guamopa.org</u>. These were also sent via email. If you did not receive it, please contact our office so that we may update our database.

General Reporting Requirements FY 2009 3rd Quarter To comply, each entity must (1) provide an electronic format of the report to all Senators (CD, diskette, and/or e-mail); (2) post the report on the website; and (3) submit one hard copy of said report to the Speaker of I Liheslaturan Guahan.				
29-113, Chapter VII, Section 2	 Reporting Requirements. No later than thirty (30) days after the end of every fiscal of FY 2009, every director, administrator or head of a government of Guam agency, including, line agencies, autonomous and semiautonomous agencies, public corporations, the President of the Mayors Council of Guam, and the Administrator of the Courts of the Judiciary of Guam, regardless of the source of the entity's appropriations and revenue, shall submit to the Public Auditor of Guam and the Speaker of 1 Liheslaturan Guahan and post on the entity's website, in written and electronic format (including, but not limited to, diskettes, CDs and email) a report making fill disclosure of ALL funds under his or her purview and administration for the preceding quarter. Said report shall be in the form of financial statements or revenue and expenditure reports for every fund he administers, regardless of the source of the funding. This and every reporting requirement imposed by this Act shall be subject to the following if any or all of the following requirements are not met: (1) providing an electronic format of the report to all Senators; (2) posting the report on the website: and (3) one hard copy of said report to the Speaker of I Liheslatura. (b) The director of any government agency receiving funds pursuant to this Act, regardless of the source of the agency's appropriations and revenue, shall have his gross salary per pay period and the gross salaries per pay period of his deputy and Chief Financial Officer reduced by twenty percent (20%) for the remainder of the Fiscal Year 2009 for failing to reporting and the sponsibility under this Section at least three (3) days before the end of each quarter. The Public Auditor shall notify all directors of their responsibility under this Section at least three (3) days before the end of a department, agency, autonomous agency, semi-autonomous agency, or public corporation, including, but not limited to, the Superintendent of Education, the President of the Guam E	3rd Quarter- 7/31/2009 4th Quarter- 10/31/2009		

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29-113. Chapter VII, Section 24	Reporting Staffing Pattern. (a) Staffing Pattern. No later than thirty (30) days after the end of each quarter of Fiscal Year 2009, every director, administrator or head of a government of Guam agency. including line agencies, semiautonomous agencies, public corporations, the President of the Mayors Council of Guam, and the Administrator of the Courts of the Judiciary of Guam, shall submit to the Speaker of I Liheslaturan Guahan and post on the agency website a current staffing pattern in the format of the Executive Branch FY 2009 Budget Call, as of the previous quarter's ending. Said staffing pattern shall include, at a minimum, the name of every current employee and his position title, salary, increment costs and benefit costs, as well as the funding source for his salary and benefits. (b) Electronic Data. In addition to the written document required by Subsection (a) hereof, reports shall be submitted in electronic format (including, but not limited to, diskettes, CD, andfor email) to the Speaker of I Liheslaturan Guahan.	3rd Quarter- 7/31/2009 4th Quarter- 10/31/2009
29-113, Chapter VI, Section 26	Federal Funding Reports. All government of Guam entities receiving Federal Funds shall submit to I Liheslaturan Guahan, and post on its website, the following quarterly reports: (a) staffing patterns of all federally-funded positions; and (b) all payments and obligations of disallowed costs. Said report shall itemize the payments of disallowed costs, to include grant title, amount paid, and source of funding.	3rd Quarter- 7/31/2009 4th Quarter- 10/31/2009
29-113, Chapter VII, Section 6	Reporting Requirements for Non-Profit Organizations. All non-profit organizations that receive funds pursuant to this Act shall maintain financial records that accurately account for said funds and shall provide a budgetary breakdown by object category to the department or agency that oversees the appropriation. The non-profit organization shall also provide to said department: (a) A quarterly report describing its activities during the reporting period and the results it achieved no later than twenty (20) days after the end of each quarter; (b) Notification of all procurement of equipment and services of Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000) or more prior to awarding the contract therefore; (c) Access to the overseeing department or agency's duly authorized representative, and Government of Guam auditors, to appropriate records for the purpose of audit and examination of books, documents, papers and records of funds expended under the appropriation; (d) Submission of a detailed inventory listing of each year's purchases, as certified by its certifying officer; (e) A Final Report to the overseeing department or agency for submission to I Liheslaturan Guahan containing a full disclosure of all expenditures of funds appropriated by this Act no later than November 15, 2009. The overseeing department or agency shall post the same on its website; and (f) Non-compliance with these reporting requirements will subject the non-profit organization to a three percent (3%) reduction of its appropriation (s) and the overseeing agency's contract with the organization shall so provide.	11/15/2009
29-113, Chapter VII, Section 20	Prior Years Obligations. Appropriations made in this Act may be expended for the payment of prior years' obligations. I Maga'lahen Guahan shall deliver notice to the Speaker of I Liheslaturan Guahan of each such proposed expenditure no less than forty-five (45) days before the expenditure. The Office of the Attorney General, the Mayors' Council of Guam, the Office of the Public Auditor, and the Judiciary of Guam shall deliver notice to the Speaker of I Liheslaturan Guahan of each proposed expenditure as mandated in this Section. The expenditure will be effective if no action is taken by I Liheslaturan Guahan. Disapproval of any proposed expenditure by I Liheslatura shall be exempt from 2 GCA § 2103. At the end of each quarter, each department shall report to I Liheslatura, and post on its website, all payments of the previous quarter's prior year(s) obligations by payee, date of payment, amount of payment, purpose of the expenditure and the reason for non-payment in the prior year.	3rd Quarter- 6/30/2009 4th Quarter- 9/30/2009
