### Layon Solid Waste Management Permitting Process

### BACKGROUND

Pursuant to the Consent Decree Order (*see* Docket No. 357), dated February 12, 2009, the Guam Environmental Protection Agency (Guam EPA) hereby submits its monthly report outlining the progress in the permitting process for a RCRA Subtitle D compliant Municipal Solid Waste Landfill Facility (MSWL) at Layon.

The highlight of events following the issuance of the aforementioned *Order*, ending June 2009, is as follows:

### 1. Source of Funding for a Technical Consultant

### a) CNMI Technical Support

Guam EPA committed its federal technical support funding so that <u>all</u> costs related to air fare and per diem for Mr. Bearden will be covered through the USEPA-Guam EPA Interagency Agreement; FY09-13 Technical Assistance to the Territory of Guam.

During June 2009, Mr. Bearden was unable to come to Guam due to other professional commitments. However, Guam EPA has continued to maintain communications with Mr. Beardon throughout this period to address ongoing matters.

### b) ASTSWMO Technical Support

No activity to report in June.

### c) USEPA, Region VI

During June 2009, Guam EPA continues to receive support through USEPA's Waste Management Division.

In addition, during June 26, 2009, the Layon and Ordot Dump sites were visited by Ms. Laura Yoshii, Acting Regional Administrator, Messrs. Enrique Manzanilla,

Communities and Ecosystems Division Director, and John McCarroll, Pacific Islands Office Manager, from the USEPA, Region IX,. The representatives were accompanied by Guam EPA and TG Engineers.

### 2. Source of Funding for Contract Support

To date, the Guam Environmental Protection Agency has identified the following sources to support the environmental technical assistance needed in meeting the timelines set forth by the Consent Decree:

### a) 2009 IAG Funding

No activity to report in June.

# b) Guam EPA Request for Proposal (RFP) and Scope of Work (SOW) for technical support for permitting (solid waste and air)

No activity to report in June.

### c) USEPA, Region IX Superfund Technical Support

No activity to report in June.

### 3. <u>Other Needs</u>

In preparation for permitting-related activities, Guam EPA has been evaluating its current funding sources to secure the needs delineated below.

a) **Public Notice Publications** – Printed advertisements for both air and solid waste permits for the Layon MSWL. Approximately two-thousand dollars (\$2,000) needed.

During this month, Guam EPA identified and allocated \$700 from its resources to fund this need;

b) **Printing** – Photocopying, binding, and e-copies of draft permits (air and solid waste) and supporting documents for public review at 4 anticipated repositories. Approximately one-thousand five-hundred dollars (\$1,500) needed.

During this month, Guam EPA identified and allocated \$1,500 from its resources to fund this need;

c) **Recording and Transcription** - Procurement of professional services for recording and transcription of public comments during town meeting. Approximately two-thousand five-hundred dollars (\$2,500) needed.

On June 24, 2009, the *Receiver* gave verbal commitment to Guam EPA to procure this service during the bi-weekly conference call;

d) **Facilitator** - Procurement of professional services for a facilitator to conduct the projected Town Meeting.

During this month, Guam EPA has been coordinating with USEPA's Waste Management Division on the specific needs and potential meeting dates. Ms. Vicki Rosen is anticipated to be the facilitator/community relations representative; and

e) **EPA Technical Support** - Technical support travel to Guam for Karen Ueno and other key staff to attend Town Meeting. During this month, Guam EPA continued its coordination with USEPA on the travel dates for the Meeting.
