Note 1:

GovGuam apppropriation revenue of \$24.4M is based on accrual basis of accounting. Cash received as of June 30, 2009 is \$ 12.5 M. Therefore, GovGuam is \$11.9M in arrears for FY09 allotments.

Using cash basis of GovGuam appropriations, the change in net assets would be a decrease of \$13M as of June 30, 2009 Accounts receivable for FY 2007 is \$138,569K and for FY08 is \$226K, based on an allotment control settlement with GovGuam.
